 - a. `abad to work (in any sense); to serve, till, (causatively) enslave, etc., keep in bondage, compel, do, dress, execute, + husbandman, keep, labor(-ing man, bring to pass, (cause to, make to) serve(-ing, self), (be, become) servant(-s), do (use) service, till(-er), transgress (from margin), (set a) work, be wrought, worshipper, b. **shamar** to hedge about (as with thorns), guard; to protect, attend to, etc.:-be circumspect, take heed (to self), keep(-er, self), mark, look narrowly, observe, preserve, regard, reserve, save (self), sure, (that lay) wait (for), watch(-man).

 - a. 'arar to execrate: bitterly curse. to declare to be evil or detestable
 - b. The Curse
 - i. 'itstsabown worrisomeness, labor or pain:--sorrow, toil.
 - ii. qowts thorn.
 - iii. dardar a thorn:--thistle. any of various prickly composite plants
 - iv. ze'ah perspiration:--sweat.
 - 3. Work as a Calling
 - a. Work is any set of tasks to be performed in pursuit of a particular goal.
 - i. There is no Biblical reason to separate the secular from the sacred
 - Eating, drinking, whatsoever 1 Co 10:31
 - whatsoever ye do in word or deed Col 3:17
 - ii. We are saved for GOOD Work Ro 6:4,11; 14:6-8; Eph 2:10
 - b. Notice: money may be the reward, but not the reason Eph 6:5-8; Pr 13:11
 - i. with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ;
 - ii. not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart,
 - iii. with goodwill doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men,
 - iv. knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord
 - 4. Two wrong attitudes about work
 - a. Complaint, burdened, resentful, unappreciative Phil 2:14
 - i. Leads to laziness
 - ii. Sees work as a necessary inconvenience on the way to the true goal in

life - weekends were made for

- b. Workaholic
 - i. Worship
 - either of the work or the money
 - finding our identity in what we do
 - greed Pr 1:19; 15:27
 - ii. A form of idolatry

 - a. Consider the Ant Pr 6:6-8
 - i. The highest form of material life learning from one of the smallest
 - ii. Consideration brings wisdom,
 - iii. Doesn't need oversight
 - iv. pursuit of a particular goal gathers her food in the harvest
 - v. Does the set of tasks to reach the goal Provides her supplies in the summer

 - i. *charuwts* incised or (active) incisive; a trench (as dug), gold (as mined), a threshing-sledge (having sharp teeth); determination; also eager:-decision, diligent, (fine) gold, pointed things, sharp, threshing instrument, ii. Diligence steady, earnest, and energetic effort, devoted and painstaking
