"CHRIST, OUR PASSOVER" part 3 1 COR. 11:23-27; SUPPORT SCRIPTURE

I. JESUS FULFILLS THE PASSOVER

- A. The witness of Scripture 1 Cor 5:7
- B. The witness of Jesus Matt 5:17; the true form of the shadows Heb 10
- C. Getting the proper <u>date</u> to match God's command
- D. Understanding the controversy -
 - 1. The differences in when a day begins and ends
 - 2. The differences in understanding when the offering is to be made 14th or 15th? De 16:6
 - 3. Different calendars give different dying days; first of Nisan always on Wednesday?
- E. Jesus is the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world John 1:29
- F. Jesus is the first-born male
- G. Must be offered in Jerusalem at the Temple
- H. Bringing the Lamb <u>home</u> on the 10th
- I. Looking for <u>blemishes</u> in the Lamb
- J. Preparing the meal on the twilight of the 14th (from 3:00 to 5:00 on that day)
- K. Sharing a Passover <u>meal</u> on the 15th
- L. Hosting the meal as the <u>priest</u> of the group; a return to the original Passover sacrifice before the Levitical priesthood; establishing a new priesthood
- M. Keeping vigil waiting for the judgment of God
- N. He offered no <u>resistance</u> as the Lamb to be sacrificed



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- O. He is being offered as a sin offering for <u>ignorant</u> people: "Father, forgive them..."
- P. He is crucified at the time the Passover lamb was sacrificed. The Lamb has to die.
- Q. It is the holiness and innocence of the sacrifice not that of the people for whom it is sacrificed that is the offering pleasing to God; it's what saves
- R. Not one of His bones were broken
- S. Each lamb was for that <u>household</u>. This Lamb dies for the whole <u>household</u> of God!
- T. The entire lamb had to be consumed or burned in the fire; could not be left mutilated. The body of Jesus was removed completely from the scene by burial.
- U. Jesus is the Passover Lamb, the sin offering, the new high priest of a new order of priests.
- II. JESUS GIVES THE CHURCH A NEW FEAST OF REMEMBRANCE FOR THE SECOND AND FINAL EXODUS
 - A. The first exodus delivered Israel from slavery in Egypt to a new prosperous land with the continuous presence of God; The second exodus delivers believers from slavery to sin and Satan to a new heavens & earth forever in His presence
 - B. No instructions to eat a sacrificed lamb; He is the Lamb, the final, single, only-needed last sacrifice
 - C. We eat the bread in the place of His flesh; we drink the juice in the place of His blood; intimacy
