

"THE MOSES OF THE FINAL EXODUS" MARK 1:40-45; EXODUS 4:1-9; SUPPORT SCRIPTURE

- I. WHAT IF THEY WON'T BELIEVE ME? Exo 4:1-9
 - *A.* God's chosen messenger, Moses, <u>doubts</u> the people will listen to him
 - B. God assures him, he will not go alone
 - C. God gives him two signs of evidence that God has sent him with this message
 - 1. The <u>staff</u> of the shepherd
 - 2. The <u>healing</u> of the incurable leprosy
 - D. If they won't believe the one sign perhaps they will believe the second
 - E. These two signs are given to <u>convince</u> those to be delivered of the legitimacy of the Deliverer and to announce to the <u>gods</u> of Egypt that it is on.
- *II. YASHUA COMES AS THE DELIVERER FOR THE FINAL EXODUS*
 - A. Moses told them God had heard their cry, was going to deliver them from slavery, and take them to the land flowing with milk and honey
 - B. Yashua was coming to deliver people from their sins and <u>restore</u> the kingdom of God forever!
 - C. What signs did He give them to know He was the Messiah? Moses: Nile to blood; Yashua: water to wine; Moses: wilderness of Sinai; Yashua: wilderness temptation; Moses: healed water; Yashua: healed diseases; gods of Egypt; demons...

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- III. THE WILLING COMPASSION OF YASHUA: RIGHTEOUS LOVE GREATER THAN LAW Mk 1:40-45
 - A. The bold <u>disobedience</u> of the leper; loss from leprosy; the boldness of Moses Ex 33:12-23
 - B. The compassion of God for those humbly bold enough to <u>ask</u> Ex 33:19; 34:5-9
 - C. The compassion of Yashua (incarnate God) to touch the unclean and incurable
 - 1. Yashua is seeing the effects of sin, uncleanness and disease on humanity; He sees its suffering and is willing to make it clean, to heal it, to restore things to their righteous estate
 - 2. The prohibitions on touching the unclean was to prevent one from becoming unclean themselves
 - 3. Yashua, the Pure One, could not be made <u>unclean</u>; He is the source of purity, the healer
 - 4. The healing of Yashua <u>reverses</u> the damage done by the disease and <u>restores</u> the affected part to wholeness and wellness
 - D. This is a sign that testifies that Jesus IS the second Moses, the Deliverer for the great and final exodus
 - E. Jesus came to <u>fulfill</u> the law not to <u>abolish</u> it
 - 1. He sternly commands the man to follow the prescription in the law and show himself to the priest with an offering Lev 14:1-32
 - 2. In true human fashion, the man <u>disobeys</u> this confirming request and tells everyone about it. This limited Yashua's accessibility to crowds
