- I. God seeks his own glory.
 - A. Time for a replacement (Philippians 3:13-14)
 - B. The house of Jesse (Genesis 49:10; Matthew 1)
 - C. God uses the un-glorious, the un-impressive, the lowly to carry out his purposes
- II. God cares more about what is inside than what is outside.
 - A. How good is good enough?
 - B. God turns his face and blesses those who love and obey him
 - C. It is contrary to *our* nature to care more about inner reality than outer appearance (Matthew 23:27)
 - D. What would our lives look like if *you* cared more about the inside than the outside?
- III. God will empower those who love him to do what they need to do.
 - A. The Spirit rushes on David, and leaves Saul (1 Samuel 10:6, 10; 11:6; Judges 14:6, 19; 15:14)
 - B. God seeks his own glory by choosing and empowering us (2 Corinthians 4:7)
 - C. God glorified himself in Jesus Christ.
