
REVELATION 3:14-22 Part 8

I. LISTENING TO THE SPIRIT

- A. *The Spirit speaks the revelation of Jesus*
- B. *For the judgment of this church Jesus reveals Himself as the Amen (the confirmation of truth), the One faithfully speaking the truth of what is happening and the One to whom all of creation owes its existence because they are its opposite.*

- B. *This led to an age of wealth for those colonizing never before known. More wealth, more education, more science, technology, machinery, communications, travel, freedom, human interaction, exposure to new ideas, art...*
- C. *More uncertainty; with so much conflicting information how would one know what is true?*



- D. *Laodicea has judged itself and has seen wealth and completeness. They need nothing, not even Jesus! They have seen there is a wealth of information available and it is impossible to know the truth. The church sees itself like the city of its placement*
- E. *Jesus sees their indecision, their boredom, their indifference to Him as lukewarm. They could not be fanatically “hot” about the gospel but they wouldn’t reject it and become cold to it. They would just hold it as another good myth and legend. There were other sons of god too!*
- F. *Jesus sees their condition quite differently: they are deeply afflicted (stressed out); pitiful; destitute; blind; and naked! The value system of Christ is obviously NOT the same as the culture’s! It is His love for the church that urges their change.*

III. JESUS’ COUNSEL TO THE LAODICEAN CHURCH


Open the door and let Him in! Get zealous and repent!

- 4. Get personal with Jesus - dine with Him!*


