•	The New Testament gives numerous qualifications that men are to meet in order for them to serve as elders in the church.					
1.	The qualities required of an elder must be clearly in his life					
	1 Tim 3.1–7 The saying is trustworthy: If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task. 2 Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. 4 He must manage his own household well, with all dignity keeping his children submissive, 5 for if someone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God's church? 6 He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil. 7 Moreover, he must be well thought of by outsiders, so that he may not fall into disgrace, into a snare of the devil.					
	<u>Titus 1.5–9</u> This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you— 6 if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. 7 For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, 8 but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. 9 He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.					
•	When a church takes these requirements, it will choose godly leaders who will be able to lead the church with integrity, humility, and wisdom, and the church will be greatly and used by the Lord!					
•	Here are twenty-one of the qualifications given in the New Testament, followed by a brief description of what they mean.					
	 Above reproach – He must demonstrate a clear pattern of godly in all things, and cannot be accused of having bad character. 					
	 Husband of one wife – He must demonstrate a commitment to being completely and loyal to his wife. 					

0	Sober-minded – He must demonstrate clear and wise caution.
0	Self-controlled – He must demonstrate that he is reasonable and makes good; not foolish, impulsive, irresponsible, or unstable.
0	Respectable – He must demonstrate that he is decent and appropriate in his toward others and in his personal habits.
0	Hospitable – Since this Greek word means to be "a lover of strangers," he must be willing to others and greet them lovingly.
0	Able to teach – He must demonstrate the ability and willingness to the truth of Scripture, and it from error.
0	Not a drunkard – He must demonstrate that he is not to alcohol or drugs.
0	Not self-willed – He must demonstrate that he is not overbearing,, or self-pleasing.
0	Not quick-tempered – He must demonstrate that he keeps his under control.
0	Not violent – He must demonstrate that he is not quick to express his anger with
