Last week we looked at James 1:19-27: Meekness, Mirror and Mission 21 Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

Closed On a beatitude from Jesus Sermon on the Mount Matthew 5:5

5 "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

Today I want to start with drawing your attention to another beatitude Matthew 5:3

3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

The more I read through James' writings the more I am convinced that Jesus' sermon is where James is drawing his teaching from.

Poor in Spirit is double entendre (In a way): One literal thought followed by a risky or edgy thought in one phrase.

- -The fact that the revelation that you are morally backrupt therefor poor in spirit
- -But a second thought when you look at the culture of Jesus day and ours.
 - if you are lame, poor, broken you must not be blessed of God
 - Jesus says you have to have the spirit of the poor. Humble, just happy to be

included.

Just as God's grace, and Justice are:

Romans 2:10-12

10 but glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek.

11 For God shows no partiality.

12 For all who have sinned without the law will also perish without the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law.

Philippians 3:7–14

7 But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ.

8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ

9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—
