Satan has been using the entire area of aliens to create that subterfuge. It has gained the distinction of sounding so scientific. Over the centuries, the idea that aliens exist has become more pronounced. It would appear that in 2011, the time is just about ripe for the final reveal. Hollywood has spent decades preparing the masses by creating a type of reality fiction from science fiction.

That together with the New Age movement, the Theosophical Society, and other esoteric groups has pushed knowledge, mysticism, and existentialism to the forefront of man's thinking.

Why do people seek the advice of tarot cards, psychics, mediums, channelers, and the like? It is because we normally want to know something about the future, don't we? We are not content to live in the *now*, so we want to see where our life is going or what we can do to bring our dreams into our reality.

Spirit guides and others do *not* have privy to the future, though they pretend they do. They only know things in generalities, such as the fact that Jesus will return one day. They also know that this world will come to an end one day. Beyond this they know that they will be cast into the Lake of Fire for all eternity. In essence, they know the Bible – what it says, what it teaches – and they understand it remarkably well. Because of this, they can easily twist it to their predetermined meaning, deceiving people in the process.

The prophesies in Scripture are known to them. But for them to try to figure out what is going to happen when and where, educated guessing is required on their part. They are often in the dark, as we are in the dark. Of course, they are not above making it up as they go along either.

When people yearn to know the future, these entities are more than happy to tell people what they want to hear. Once they do, it is something that people will often try to bring about, whether consciously or subconsciously. If it doesn't happen as it was revealed to them, they will often blame it on themselves.

Isn't this the exact same situation when we listen to people who attempt to con us out of something? I've been had and maybe you have too.

While you're going through the process, sometimes there is a weird feeling you get that acts as a red flag. Something is telling you to move away and forget the whole thing, but you override that instinct. You push on ahead and after all is said and done you realize that

you were *taken* for a bit of a ride. It happens all the time in society and to many people on a daily basis.

If human beings do this to one another, why should we believe that entities who reside in the fourth dimension would not be capable of the same thing? Someone will say, "Well, look at what these entities are telling us about love and living divinely. Shouldn't that mean that they are being honest?" No.

Why does the Bible teach us to *test* the spirits if they are not capable of lying to us? "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world" (1 John 4:1-3).

What the apostle John is saying is that spirits are very capable of *lying*. For fallen angels, their natural language – like Satan's, their overlord – is lying. They exist to deceive. We know from the example of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness that Satan crafted special meanings for the Scripture he used to test Jesus (cf. Matthew 4).

Paul tells us that Satan himself is *transformed* into an angel of light (cf. 2 Corinthians 11:14). This should clue us into the fact that both fallen angels and Satan tell lies and present themselves as something they are not for their own purposes and gain. They *want* to deceive. That is their ultimate goal.

If they want to deceive us, the question must be asked *why* they want to deceive us. What possible purpose could they have to attempt to pull the wool over people's eyes? Let's see if we can determine the answer to that question.

Who is this Jesus anyway? This question was asked by an avenging angel named Azazel in the NBC TV mini-series called *The Fallen*. Aaron Corbet – a character on the show, who recently turned 18 and discovered he was one of the *Nephilim* – told him that "a lot of people believe that Jesus is God's Son."

Azazel's response to this was hearty laugh. Aaron asked him if he was serious that he had not known about Jesus, to which Azazel responded that he had "been away for a while." In fact, Azazel had been chained to a rock for 5,000 years. He was now free after making a deal with the devil to help protect Aaron, who, as it turns out, is *The Redeemer*. The Redeemer was prophesied to come and redeem those angels who had fallen so that they could return to heaven, their first estate.
