Confidence in Grace Galatians 3:1-9

Confidence in God's grace comes with:

- I. Experience "the truth, before whose eyes" (vs. 1-5)

 God gives us the:
 - A. Son "Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth"
 - **B.** Spirit "received ye the Spirit"
 - C. Signs-"worketh miracles among you"
- II. Exeges is "know ye therefore" (vs. 6-7)

 God's Word explains the:
 - A. Reliance "even as Abraham believed God"
 - B. Reckoning "was accounted to him for righteousness"
 - C. Relationship "the same are the children of Abraham"
- III. Expectation "the scripture, foreseeing that God" (vs. 8-9) God's grace has been:
 - A. Consistent "God would justify the heathen through faith"
 - B. Communicated "preached the gospel unto Abraham"
 - C. Copious "In thee all nations be blessed"

Sentence Sermon:

"Salvation in the Bible has always been by Grace through Faith."
