Jehovah God

"And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you."

(Exodus 3:14)

he name Jehovah is the most frequently employed name in the Old Testament. It appears 6,823 times. The name JEHOVAH reveals His redemptive relationship to His elect and is always used in that covenant relationship with His chosen people. When He revealed Himself as Jehovah to Moses, it was to manifest His power as God to deliver the children of Israel from Egypt through the Passover Lamb. In the New Testament, the LORD Jesus is none other than God manifest in the flesh, <u>1 Timothy 3:16</u>.

Many times the LORD Jesus referred to Himself as the I AM of God Himself: I AM the bread of life: <u>John 6:35-51</u>, I AM the Light of the world: <u>John 8:12</u>; <u>John 9:5</u>, I AM the Door of the sheep: <u>John 10:7-9</u>, I AM the Good Shepherd: <u>John 10:11-14</u>, I AM the Resurrection and the Life: <u>John 11:25</u>, I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life: <u>John 14:6</u>, I AM the True Vine: <u>John 15:1</u>. To believe in God (Jehovah) is to believe in the LORD Jesus as Jehovah God. That's why there is no redemption apart from Him. <u>John 8:24</u>: "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I AM, ye shall die in your sins." Then the seven redemptive names of the LORD in the Old Testament are a revelation of the same LORD Jesus Christ in the New.

1 - JEHOVAH ROHI – THE LORD MY SHEPHERD

The LORD is my Shepherd, I shall not want, Psalm 23:1 with Christ the Good Shepherd, John 10:1-18.

2 - JEHOVAH JIREH - THE LORD MY PROVIDER

And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah Jireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen, <u>Genesis 22:14</u>, Jesus Christ is the God provided Lamb for the complete salvation of His elect, <u>John 8:56</u>.

3 - JEHOVAH RAPHA - THE LORD MY HEALER

for I am the LORD that healeth thee, *Exodus 15:26*, fulfilled in the LORD Jesus, "by whose stripes we are healed," 1 Peter 2:24.

4 - JEHOVAH SHALOM - THE LORD MY PEACE

Then Gideon built an altar there unto the LORD and called it Jehovah Shalom: <u>Judges 6:24</u>. Jesus Christ the Peace of His elect, <u>John 14:27</u>, as their Representative before the Father.

5 - JEHOVAH NISSI - THE LORD MY BANNER

And Moses built an altar and called the name of it Jehovah Nissi- <u>Exodus 17:15</u>. The LORD Jesus was lifted up on the cross and is today the banner of His people to whom they look as their justification, sanctification, and redemption, <u>I Corinthians 1:30</u>.

<u>6 - JEHOVAH TSIDKENU – THE LORD MY RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>

In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS, <u>Jeremiah 23:6</u>. The LORD Jesus earned and established that Righteousness necessary for God to be just to justify the elect by His life and death, <u>Romans 4:25</u>.

7 - JEHOVAH SHAMMAH – THE LORD IS THERE FOR ME

and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there, <u>Ezekiel 48:35</u>. The LORD Jesus assured His disciples as He ascended in glory, **Lo I** am with you always, even unto the end of the world, <u>Matthew 28:20</u>.

What a Mighty God He is! Jesus Christ our Creator, Sovereign, Redeemer, King! He is the Eternal God. He is All-Sufficient, the Source of blessing and Owner, our LORD. He is the LORD Who provides all we are and have by His Grace alone. He is the LORD Who heals, the LORD over His people as their Victorious Banner. He is the LORD Who justifies and sanctifies, and therefore the LORD our Peace. He is the LORD our Righteousness. He is the LORD, our Shepherd Who feeds, leads and protects His own. He is the LORD Who is ever present with His own.

You hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins. Eph. 2:1



"... Christ in you the hope of glory..." (Colossians 1:27)



- 1. A firm expectation of all promised good things as long as they give God His glory. Most especially it is the hope of salvation and happiness in Heaven where we shall be completely conformed to Christ the Son of the Living God.
- 2. This hope is founded on the grace, blood, righteousness and intercession of Christ alone and the earnest of the Holy Spirit and unchangeable truth, and almighty power of God, which always agree with the Word.
- 3. This hope is different than worldly hope. Its Object (Christ) is excellent, true, faithful, steadfast and sure. The God Who cannot lie will never deceive or disappoint our hopes. He does all things to prove Himself as the Living Hope to each of His own. Paul wrote in 2 Timothy 1:12: "I know WHOM I have believed."
 - **4**. This hope which is in the living LORD has a cleansing effect, <u>1 John 3:3</u>.
