Equality with GodUnashamed of the Godhead

Realized These 2 studies were really a by-product of years of study at least for me personally

It can be said that after plowing the Word for 20+ years it was time for that Word implanted in me to bear its fruit – and boy did it!
 Here were some of those truths and learnings...

Jesus asked His disciples 'Who do you say that I am?"

A Peter answered "You are the CHRIST, the SON OF THE LIVING GOD" – Mt 16:16

Real The disciples' confession is our confession as well

IESUS IS AND WAS THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD IN HUMAN FORM

Although Jesus is and was GOD IN THE FLESH, there were some limitations even to His greatness and omniscience compared to His Father:

John 14:28 (Jesus's Own lips) You heard that I said to you, 'I go away, and I will come to you.' If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because I go to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

Matthew 24:36 (Jesus speaking) "But of that day and hour [concerning His coming and the end of the age] no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone

Rebuttal

And that humanness somehow limited His omniscience and greatness

And to that I reply with Scripture:

Philippians 2:5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, although He [speaking of Christ Jesus] existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped Colossians 1:19 For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him [speaking of Christ Jesus]

So even though Christ was human, he never ceased to possess all attributes and qualities or the fullness of being God!

ADMONITION

Recan't pick and chose our doctrine on Who God is

Resus was and is God, God the Son in the flesh, but yet in certain things the Father placed limitations on Him for a time

↔ The fact is Jesus called His Father "My God"

As He was dying on the cross He cried out "<mark>MY GOD, MY GOD</mark>, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?" – Mt 27:46, Mk 15:34

In the letter to Sardis Jesus said there "Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God." – Rev 3:2

In the letter to Philadelphia Jesus said there "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name." – Rev 3:12

BONUS SCRIPTURE

Hebrews chapter 1
Still not convinced
Let's hear from the Father's very own lips His opinion as to Who Christ is

Hebrews 1:5-14 (NASB) 5 For to which of the angels did He ever say, "YOU ARE MY SON, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU"? And again, "I WILL BE A FATHER TO HIM AND HE SHALL BE A SON TO ME"? 6 And when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says, "AND LET ALL THE ANGELS OF GOD WORSHIP HIM."

7 And of the angels He says, "WHO MAKES HIS ANGELS WINDS, AND HIS MINISTERS A FLAME OF FIRE." 8 But of the Son He says, "YOUR THRONE, O GOD, IS FOREVER AND EVER, AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM. 9 "YOU HAVE LOVED RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HATED LAWLESSNESS; THEREFORE GOD, YOUR GOD, HAS ANOINTED YOU WITH THE OIL OF GLADNESS ABOVE YOUR COMPANIONS."

10 And,

"YOU, LORD, IN THE BEGINNING LAID THE FOUNDATION OF THE EARTH,

AND THE HEAVENS ARE THE WORKS OF YOUR HANDS; 11 THEY WILL PERISH, BUT YOU REMAIN; AND THEY ALL WILL BECOME OLD LIKE A GARMENT, 12 AND LIKE A MANTLE YOU WILL ROLL THEM UP; LIKE A GARMENT THEY WILL ALSO BE CHANGED. BUT YOU ARE THE SAME, AND YOUR YEARS WILL NOT COME TO AN END."

13 But to which of the angels has He ever said, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES A FOOTSTOOL FOR YOUR FEET"?

14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

TRUTH: I want to point out a truth in verses 8-9

8 But of the Son He says,
"YOUR THRONE, O GOD, IS FOREVER AND EVER,
AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM.
9 "YOU HAVE LOVED RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HATED LAWLESSNESS;
THEREFORE GOD, YOUR GOD, HAS ANOINTED YOU
WITH THE OIL OF GLADNESS ABOVE YOUR COMPANIONS."

TRUTH: The Father addresses Christ as "O GOD", yet also addresses Himself to Christ as "GOD, YOUR GOD"

- So although Jesus is and was God, the Christ, the Son of God in the flesh, He is and was not the Father, He is not greater than His Father, for a time He was not as fully omniscient as His Father
- R In fact the Father is His God and our God too
- C Thus, when Jesus was calling God His own His Father claiming equality with God in John 5 or when Paul speaks of the humiliation and exaltation of Christ in Phi 2, this did not mean that Jesus and the Father are 50/50!

GREAT TRUTH

The great truth in the matter is:

- A The Son is the Undisputed Greatest and Only Son of God! Only Begotten of God Almighty! Son of the Most High God!
- And the Father has granted all His authority in heaven and on earth, including the title Lord and Savior to Christ Jesus!

As Paul put it, every knee will bow and every tongue will confess to this! - Phi 2:10

- - **C**^s "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me" Jn 4:34
 - "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me." Jn 6:38
- Apart from the Father, Jesus alone is to be fully worshiped, adored, loved and obeyed!
