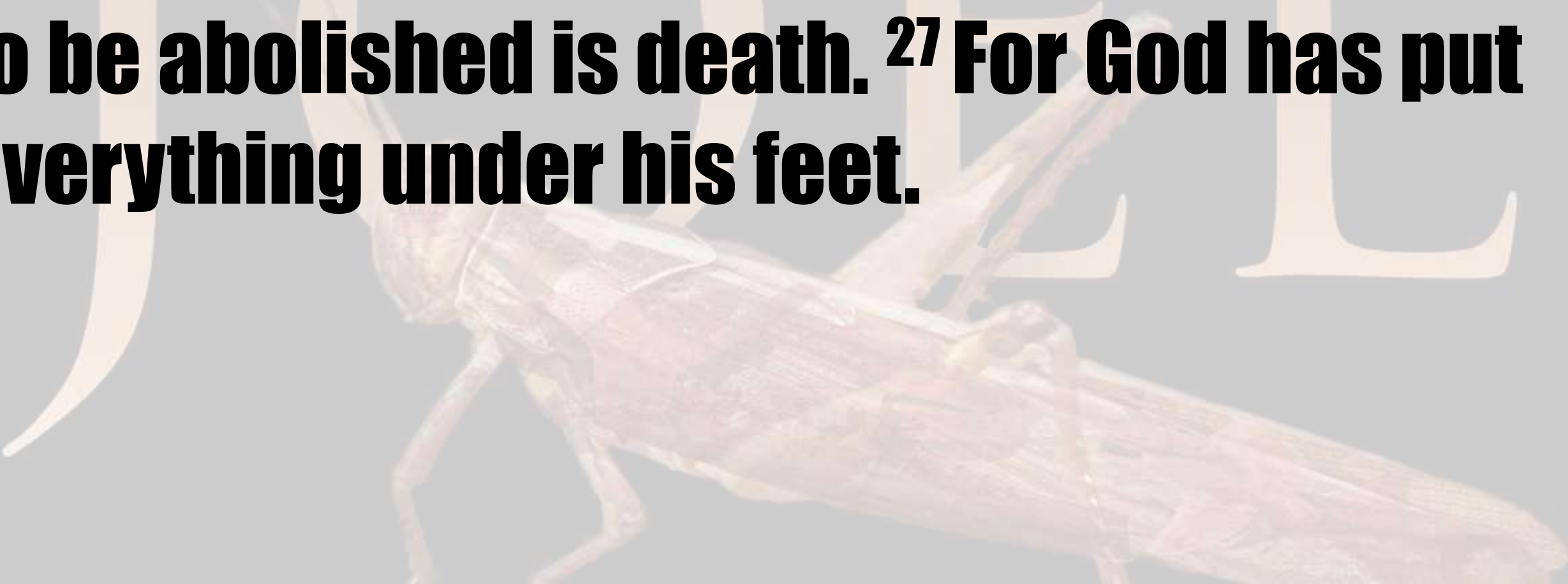


1 Corinthians 15:20-22
