- **B. ENLIVENING IN HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS** (justification, sanctification; Rom.5:1f(chps.3,4); 6:3-5)
- C. ONE SIGN WITH TWOFOLD SIGNIFICANCE (2Cor.5:21; Eph.4:20f&25f; see Lk.22:19f)
- **D. SIGN: TO BE SEEN** (Mt.24:30; see Is.40:5(Lk.3:6); Ezk.20:48; see Acts 16:33)

### II. THE WORDS OF BAPTISM: INTO THE NAME

#### A. NAME

- 1. The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (Mt.28:18-20; see 2Cor.13:14; note: A.A.A.)
- 2. (Lord) Jesus (Christ): one and therefore all (Acts 2:38; 8:12,16; 10;48; 19:5; see Jn.14:9,26; 15:26; Eph.2:18; Rom.8:9; 1Jn.2:23)
- 3. ownership: jealousy; provision, protection//allegiance (Is.43:1,7; Rev.2:13; see 1Cor.6:20; 7:23)
- **B. INTO** (Rom.6:3; see Mt.28:19,Grk.; see *Dynamic of the Biblical Ethic* in <u>Principles of Conduct</u>, John Murray; TCP)
  - 1. union (Rom.6:3,5; see 1Cor.12:13)
  - 2. sufferings; *crucifixion, death, burial* // *resurrection, life*; glorification (Rom.6:3-6,11; 8:17; see Col.2:10-12; 2:20&3:1f; 3:9&10; 3:5f&3:12f)
  - 3. note: the baptism of Jesus by John (Mt.3:13f; Mk.1:9f; Lk.3:21f)

- 3. biblical illustrations: piece-lump (Rom.11:16a); root-branch (Rom.11:16bf; see 1Cor.7:14); citizenship (Phil.3:20); inheritance (Gal.3:29f)
- 4. great difference between children of believers and children of unbelievers (Rom.11:16b,17; 20-23)

- C. BAPTIZED: A CALL TO PERSEVERANCE & IMPROVEMENT (1Pt.3:21 & 2Pt.1:9,5f; Song 5:3; see Phil.3:12; Col.3:9,10,5f; see Mt.28:18-20; see Larger Catechism, Q.167)
