1. An important example to follow. (Jesus)

- Grace and truth. John 1:14
 - An immoral Samaritan woman. John 4:5-26
 - An adulteress. John 8:1-11
 - Tax collectors and sinners. *Luke 5:27-32; 15:1; 19:1-9*

2. Important guidelines to follow.

- Remember they are not the enemy. Ephesians 6:12
- Avoid extremes.
- Pause. James 1:19-20 Proverbs 15:28; 18:2, 13, 15
- Ask questions. (The "Columbo Plan")
- Leave the stones on the ground and check for logs.
 John 8:7-9 Matthew 7:1-5
- Stand firm on what is written.
- Practice the "right" principles. (What you do or say)
 Right thing Right time Right way
- Keep the door open.
- Pray. Colossians 4:2 Philippians 4:6-7 Ephesians 6:18 Luke 18:1-8
