"The Days of Noah – Part 2" Genesis 6:1-7

(1) Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, (2) that the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose. (3) And the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." (4) There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown. (5) Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. (6) And the LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. (7) So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."

INTRO

Matthew 24:37 But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

What were the days of Noah like?

Review:

I. They Were Days of Exponential Multiplication 1

(1) Now it came to pass, when men began to **multiply** massive increase on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them,

II. They Were Days of Unusual Demon Possession 2

(2) that the sons of God demons – angels who were cast out of heaven with Satan when he rebelled against God saw the

daughters of men, that they were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose.

I want us to think about a few other ramifications of what was taking place at that time:

- 1. Every child born as the result of these unions had a demon possessed father.
- 2. They lived in a home that was influenced and dominated by a demon and the demonic forces of Satan.
- 3. Our world today is influenced and dominated by demons more than we realize or know {my experience in drug and alcohol recovery ministry mind altering drugs and alcohol open up the mind and souls of men and women to Satanic and demonic influence, if not outright possession. WARNING!}

III. They Were Days of Spiritual Persuasion 3

- (3) And the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not strive with contend, plead, deal with man mankind forever, for he *is* indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years till the flood."
- **1 Peter 3:20** ... the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while *the* ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.
- **2 Peter 2:5** ... but [God] saved Noah, *one of* eight *people*, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;
- **Jude 1:14-15** Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, **(15)** to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
 - The Holy Spirit was at work
 - Noah was preaching
 - God was giving mankind an opportunity to repent
 - God was patient: 120 years
 - Noah preached and built {like Nehemiah: sword & trowel}
 - Zero converts except for his family

Matthew 24:38-39 For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah

entered the ark, **(39)** and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

IV. They Were Days of Powerful Oppression 4

Genesis 6:4 with parenthesis added There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, (when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men and they bore *children* to them). Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.

giants = Nephilim; "a faller on" or "feller"; a "bully", a "tyrant" (only elsewhere in Numbers 13:33)

mighty men = powerful tyrants, men of authority and position

- They may have been large and powerful physically, also
- But the primary meaning here is that they were powerful in the way they dominated and ruled over other men.
- These men were overlords their motto was "might makes right"!

Men like Lamech (the descendant of Cain): Genesis 4:23-24
Then Lamech said to his wives: "Adah and Zillah, hear my voice; Wives of Lamech, listen to my speech! For I have killed a man for wounding me, Even a young man for hurting me. (24) If Cain shall be avenged sevenfold, Then Lamech seventy-sevenfold."

These men were overlords – their motto was "might makes right"

Quote from a text message I received: "Anyone paying attention can see this is a concerted effort to tear down America ... We are experiencing the beginnings of an attempt to impose a police state, but they don't quite have all the power needed to make it stick. They are trying to make it appear so, though, because if they can make enough people scared, it will stick. They are weakening structural strengths for this reason. The dollar is weakening, our military, our military, our morality, our patriotism, our trust in government and each other, respect for life, education, etc. If we send all the men off to war after letting who knows come into the country, we may see a violent takeover. They have already determined we will not stand up to tyranny as long as it is presented as safety for own benefit. We've shown ourselves to be fearful more than faithful, and so the time is ripe for a takeover if there ever was one ... Some, in my opinion, are just demon possessed."}

V. They Were Days of Moral Perversion 5-7

(5) Then the LORD saw that the wickedness* of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil* continually*. (6) And the LORD was sorry* that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. (7) So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry* that I have made them."

wickedness (v. 5) = moral defiance of God and what He has established to be right; deliberately doing what is wrong in rebellion against God

evil (v. 5) = moral perversity and wickedness that has been planned and premeditated without regard for God or man – particularly that which is injurious to others.

Genesis 6:11-13 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was **filled with violence**. **(12)** So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth. **(13)** And God said to Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is **filled with violence** through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

Psalms 14:1-3 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. The fool has said in his heart," *There is* no God." They are corrupt, They have done abominable works, There is none who does good.

(2) The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God. **(3)** They have all turned aside, They have together become corrupt; *There is* none who does good, No, not one.

Ecclesiastes 9:3 ... Truly the hearts of the sons of men are full of evil; madness *is* in their hearts while they live ...

continually (v. 5) = two words in the Hebrew – "every day"

sorry (**vv. 6-7**) = to sigh or breathe out strongly; to be grieved or pained

Isaiah 46:9-10 Remember the former things of old, For I *am* God, and *there is* no other; *I am* God, and *there is* none like Me, **(10)** Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times *things* that are not *yet* done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,'

Numbers 23:19 "God *is* not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

Ezekiel 33:11 Say to them: 'As I live,' says the Lord GOD, 'I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live. Turn, turn from your evil ways! For why should you die, O house of Israel?'

Luke 19:41-42 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, **(42)** saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things *that make* for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.

Later Jesus lamented and wept over Jerusalem ... "Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem ..."

Conclusion / Application

Are we living in the "days of Noah" that Jesus referred to in Matthew 24:37-39?

2 Timothy 3:1-13 & Romans 1:18-32

What must we do? How should we then live?

We must remember that the battle is a spiritual battle – Ephesian 6:10-13 (the armor of God)

- **2 Corinthians 10:3-5** For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.
- **(4)** For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, **(5)** casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ

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
