- **I. A**ssessment "heard the words of Laban's sons" (vs. 1-3) *Evaluating things concerning :*
 - A. Reputation "Jacob hath taken away...our father's"
 - B. Relationships "Jacob beheld the countenance of Laban"
 - C. Revelation "the Lord said unto Jacob, Return..."
- II. Acceptance "Jacob sent...called Rachel and Leah" (vs. 4-13)

 Embracing trends in things:
 - A. Encountered "with all my power...served your father"
 - B. Endured "all that Laban hath doeth unto thee"
 - C. Endued "the God of my father hath been with me"
- III. Ambition "Whatsoever God hath said to thee, do"(vs. 14-16)

 Enjoying thoughts of:
 - A. Future "Is there yet any portion or inheritance for us"
 - B. Family "counted of him strangers...he hath sold us..."
 - C. Favor "God hath taken from our father, that is our's"

Sentence Sermon:

"A good move is launched from a state of obedience while maintaining a heart of surrender to God's will."
