"Never Forget" Romans 7:13-20 Introduction: Sometimes - In The History Of The World: 1. - There Are Events That Take Place: - *Tragic* Events: - That Take The World By Storm - And: - That Take The World By Surprise! - Tragedies Like: - The Terror Attacks: - On The United States: - On 9/11/2001! - And Tragedies Like: - The Surprise Attack: - On Pearl Harbor: - On December 7, 1941: - Which Was Described At That Time As: - "A Date That Will Live In Infamy!" - And Even The Greatest Tragedy: - In The Modern Era: - The Great Holocaust: - That Took Over 6 Million Jewish Lives: - From This Earth! When These Tragedies Happen: 2. - Those Who Live Through Them: - Swear That They Will: - "Never Forget!" - And So - They Try To Memorialize And Enshrine Those Events: - For Themselves And For Those Who Will Come Behind Them! - So That They Will: - "Never Forget!" - But - Do They? Do We? - "Never Forget?" - Unfortunately, All Too Often: - We Do Forget! - As Time Marches On: - And Lives Carry On: - Those Events & Tragedies: - Become More & More Distant: - Not Only In Time: - But Also In Memory! But - How Much Would This World Benefit: 3. - And - How Much Would We Benefit: - If That Motto Held True! - If We Did, In Fact, "Never Forget!" - Especially Since - The War: - That Was Started On 9/11 Almost 20 Years Ago: - Has Never Ended! - Well - The Same Thing: - Is True - When It Come To: - Our Spiritual Lives - There Are Some Things: - That We - Who Are Christians: - Should And Must Never Forget: - About Our Walk With God! And - As We Return To: 4. - Romans 7 This Morning:

- We Need To Remember That:

- The War That Was Started:

- In The Garden Of Eden:

- For The Souls Of Mankind:

- Has Never Ended Either!

- And So - The Battle With Sin:

- Even In The Lives Of Believers In Christ:

- Continues!

- And The Apostle Paul Reminds Us Of This Truth:

- Throughout This Chapter!

5. Because - Even Though:

- As A Christian, You May Be:

- Dead To Sin - As He Already Explained:

- Even Using Several Illustrations In Chapter 6:

- Yet - Sin Is Not Entirely:

- Dead To You, Nor Is It Entirely:

- Dead In You!

- And So - Paul:

- Gives His Own Personal Experience:

- Of How Sin - And The Ultimate Source Of Sin:

- Tries To Use:

- Even The Good Things That God Has Done & The Good Things God Has

Given:

- Like His Own Law:

- To Deceive Us And To Defile Us, To The Point Of Despair!

- Sin Even Tries To Get Us To Wonder:

- Is God And His Law:

- Really All That Good?

- After All:

- Doesn't His Law Serve To:

- Actually Highlight My Disobedience And Bring About My Despair?

6. Well - In The Verses We Come To This Morning:

- Romans 7:13-20 - Not Only Does The Apostle Paul:

- Answer These Questions - But:

- He Also Gives Us Three Things That We Must:

- "Never Forget" - When It Comes To:

- The Ongoing Battle With Sin:

- In Your Life As A Believer!

- Let's Read Those Verses Together - From 7:12:

- "Wherefore the law [is] holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good. / Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful. / For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin. / For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. / If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that [it is] good. / Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. / For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do. / Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me!"

. So - Even Though Sin:

- Tries To Take - What God Meant For Good:

- His Own Law - And Use It:

- For Its Own Evil Purposes:

- To Keep You From The Light And Truth:

- Of The Gospel!

- Yet - God Turns The Tables:

- On Sin And On Satan:

- And Uses His Law:

- To Point You To Your Desparate Need Of Jesus Christ!

- And So - God Reveals:

- The True Nature Of Sin!

- And That Is - The First Thing:

- That You Must "Never Forget" As A Christian!

* Never Forget:

1. The True Nature Of Wickedness!

- Which Is What We Find In:

- 7:13 - "Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful!"
- In Context - "That Which Is Good" Is:

- The Law Of God!

- And Sin Tries To Convince Us:

- That It Is God's Law:

- That Is At Fault:

- And Not Our Sin!

- That God's Law:

- Is The Source:

- Of Our Sin - And:

- That God's Law:

- Is The Source:

- Of Our Death!

- But - Paul's Answer To Both Questions:

- 7:7 - "Is The Law Sin?" - And:

- 7:13 - "Is The Law Death?"

- Is - "God Forbid!"

- We Must Not Ever Think This Way About God And His Law!

- Because - The Cause Of Both:

- Is Sin & Only Sin!

- Because - When It Comes To Your Soul:

- The Intent:

- Of Sin Is & Always Has Been:

- To Slay You!

- It Isn't God's Good Law:

- That Defiles You & Deceives You:

- And Discourages You!

- No - It Is The Sin Within You!

- Your Own Sin!

- This Is The Point That Paul Brought Out:

- Back In 7:11 - "For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew [me]!"

- And We Must Never Forget: - This Intent Of Sin!

- 11118 11110

- Even As We Are Told In:

- James 1:15 - "Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death!"

- But - We Also See:

- The Iniquity:

- Of Sin - That Is:

- There Is Absolutely Nothing Good:

- In It Or About It!

- It Can Even Take What *Is* Good:

- And Try To Use It For Its Own Wicked Purposes!

- That's Why Paul Adds:

- 7:13b - "But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good!"

- Again - What God Meant For Good:

- Sin Uses For Evil:

- In Order To Keep The Sinner In Its Grasp!

- But - By Doing So: - It Reveals Its True Nature! - A Nature Of Total Darkness: - That Will Always: - Lead To Despair! - Because - We Also See: - The Intensity: - Of Sin - In 7:13c: - "That sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful!" - Sin Is Greedy! - It Always Takes: - And Is Never Satisfied: - Until It Takes All! - IE: It Is Like An Enemy Spy When He Gets Exposed! At That Point - There Is Nothing To Lose! Going To Try To Take As Many Out With Him As Possible! - This Is What Sin Does As Well! - God - Through His Good Law: - Exposes The True Nature Of Sin! - It's Intent - To Slay You! - It's Iniquity - And Complete Darkness! - And - It's Intensity - Its "Exceeding Sinfulness!" - And - There Are Times: - When Even Those Who Are: - Steeped In And Addicted To: - Certain Sins - Themselves: - Come To Hate Their Sin & Even Hate Themselves: - Because Of Their Sin! - They Hate It: - Even Though: - They Can't Escape It! - And All Of This Exposes: - The True Nature Of Sin! - And We Must Never Forget It! - Have You? - Does Sin Not Seem So Sinful Anymore? - Need To Remember: - There Is Absolutely Nothing: - Good About Sin! * But Then - A Second Thing - That You And I Must Never Forget - Is: The True Nature Of The Word! - The True Nature Of God's Word & God's Law: - 7:14 - "For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin!" - Going To Focus On: - Just The First Part Of This Verse: - For A Bit! - "For we know that the law is spiritual!" - What Does This Mean? - Well - Based On What Paul Already Tells Us About God's Law - In 7:12: - It Means That God's Word & God's Law: - Is "Holy And Just And Good!" - As A Whole & In All Of Its Parts! - But - It Also Means That: - The Source - Of God's Law: - Is Spiritual! - The Word & The Law Of God: - Reflects The Very Character And Nature: - Of God Himself!

- And - Since God Is A Spirit: - John 4:24 - "God [is] a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth!" - Then - That Which Comes Forth From Him: - Is Spiritual As Well! - God's Law Is Spiritual: - Because It Comes From: - A Spiritual God! - But - This Also Means That: - The Substance - Of God's Law: - Is Spiritual! - To Be "Spiritual" Often Refers To Something: - That Is "Absolute And Unmixed!" - IE: Like Pure Water - With Nothing Dissolved Into It! - This Is: - What The Law And The Word Of God: - Is Like! - It Is Perfect: - And - It Is Pure! - Psalm 19:7-9 - "The law of the LORD [is] perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD [is] sure, making wise the simple. / The statutes of the LORD [are] right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD [is] pure, enlightening the eyes. / The fear of the LORD [is] clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD [are] true [and] righteous altogether!" - God's Law Is Spiritual: - Because It Has: - A Nature That Is Perfect And Pure! - But - It Also Means That: - The Strength - Of God's Law: - Is Spiritual! - That Is - It Was Never Meant: - To Be Just A Physical And External: - Restraint On Your Behavior! - The Spiritual Law Of God: - Speaks To: - The Spiritual Nature: - Of Man! - God Uses It: - To Convict Your Conscience: - Not Just To: - Condemn Your Acts! - And All Of This Expresses: - The True Nature Of God's Law: - And We Must Never Forget It! - Have You? - Does The Bible Just Seem Like Any Other Book? Something Can Just Take Or Leave? - Need To Remember: - God's Law Is Spiritual: - And Is Always: - "Holy And Just And Good!" * But - How Do We As Christians - Interact With These Two Opposing Forces? - Sin And The Law?

- Well In The Rest Of The Verses Of This Chapter:
 - Paul Wants Us To "Never Forget":

- That There Is A Tension: - For As Long As A Christian Lives In This World: - Between The Wickedness Of Sin: - And The Goodness Of God's Law! - And This Is Because: - There Is Within A Child Of God: - A New Sensitivity To Sin! - Which Is What We Find In: - 7:14b - "But I am carnal, sold under sin!" - To Be "Carnal" Here: - Is Something In Contrast With: - The "Spiritual" Nature Of God's Word And Law! - Whereas The Nature Of God's Law: - Is Unmixed Perfection & Purity: - Our Nature - As Christians: - Is Mixed! - Now - We Believe That: - Paul Is Speaking Here: - As A Christian - Because: - From This Point On Until The End Of The Chapter: - He Uses Verbs In The Present Tense - Versus - Past Tense - In 7:7-12! - So - This Is His New Experience As A Christian! - And He Knows That: - There Is Still Within Him: - That Old Fleshly Nature: - That Is Still Weak, And Worldly, And Greatly Wanting! - Not That He Is Content: - With This - Even As We Should Not Be! - But - Here - He Is Just Stating Things As They Are! - He Is Still - And - We Are Still: - "Carnal" - Because: - We Were - At One Point: - Completely "Sold Under Sin!" - We Were Its Slaves! - And Even Though We Know: - That Sin Is No Longer Our Master: - Sin Doesn't Quite See It That Way Yet! - As We Will Sing Shortly: - From Thomas Dorsey's Hymn: - "Precious Lord, Take My Hand, Lead Me On, Let Me Stand, I Am Tired, I Am Weak, I Am Worn!" - Even Though We Don't Like It: - This Is Our Present Condition! - There's A New Man Within Us - Yes! - But - There's That Old Man: - Still Clinging On! - But - Even This Awareness And New Sensitivity: - Is Evidence Of The New Creature God Has Made You To Be! - But - To Explain What He Means: - When He Says That He And We Are: - "Carnal" - He Then Reveals That There Is: - A New Struggle Against Sin! - In 7:15-16 - "For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. / If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that [it is] good." - Here - The Experience Paul Has: - Is A Common One For All Believers! - And It Is:

- A Confusing Struggle - At Times!

- 7:15a - "For that which I do I allow not!"

- "Allow" - Ginosko - To Know:

- I Don't Understand!

- Why Did I Do That?

- How Could I Do That?

- A Concerning Struggle At Times!

- 7:15b - "For what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I!"

- Shows An Internal Conflict:

- Between What:

- You Desire - And What:

- You Detest!

- But - Where Does That Desire:

- And New Will Come From?

- Philippians 2:13 - "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of [his] good pleasure!"

- And So:

- Even Though The Struggle Within You:

- May Be Confusing At Times And:

- Concerning At Times:

- It Still:

- A Convincing Struggle:

- Because - It Shows That:

- God Is Still At Work In Your Life:

- Convincing You Of What Is True And Right And Good!

- 7:16 - "If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that [it is] good!"

- So - This New Struggle:

- That Is Within You:

- Between The Wicked Nature Of Sin And:

- The Good Nature Of God's Word:

- Shows God's Work Still Going On Within You!

- And That Leads To:

- A New Sense Of Sin!

- In 7:17-19 - "Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. / For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but [how] to perform that which is good I find not. / For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do!"

- So - The Question Often Comes:

- Why The Struggle?

- Why Still Sin?

- Where Does It Come From?

- Never Forget:

- Though You Are Dead To Sin:

- Sin Is Not Quite Yet Dead:

- To You / In You!

- Because Of:

- The Remaining Tenacity Of Sin:

- 7:17 - "Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me!"

- This Is Not An Excuse - But An Explanation!

- There Is - Living In Every Believer:

- A Dying - But Still An:

- Indwelling Sin!

- IE: Like A Drowning Spider - Very Tenacious - Still Hanging On!

- But - You Must Never Forget:

- Who Really Is Your New Master And Owner And Inhabitant Of The House Of

Your Soul!

- Also:

- The Remaining Taint Of Sin:

- 7:18a - "For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing!"

- Sin Still Taints Your Flesh: - Your Fallen Nature! - And So - In That Old Man: - That Still Indwells You: - There Is No Good! - Nothing Beautiful! - Nothing Beneficial! - Not Referring To: - The Image Of God Within You: - That Is The Value & Worth: - Of Your Soul! - But - In Your Flesh: - You Can't Please God! - And This Leads To: - The Remaining Trap Of Sin: - 7:18b-19 - "For to will is present with me; but [how] to perform that which is good I find not. / For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do!" - Again - Not An Excuse - But An Explanation! - Even Though: - There Is Now The: - Will & The Desire: - To Do Good: - Given By God! - There Is Still: - The Way: - Of Doing Good: - That Is Often Blocked By Sin And Flesh! - Remember - Matthew 26:41: - "Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed [is] willing, but the flesh [is] weak!" - Need To Keep Watching & Keep Praying! - And Paul Provides: - An Example Of What This Trap Feels Like: - For A Christian! - Ever Feel This Way? - 7:19 - "For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do!" - What's Going On? What Am I To Do? - This Is Still God And His Law At Work In Your Life! - So - Even With Sin's Tenacity & Taint & Trap: - You Still Have: - A New Strength Over Sin! - 7:20 - "Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me!" - Its Not The New You: - It's the Old You! - So: - Sin Is No Longer: - A Natural, Normal Thing: - For You! It Is: - Unnatural / Abnormal! - Out Of Character! - So - Never Forget: - The True Nature: - Of Your Walk With Christ! - It Is Still A Struggle! - Galatians 5:17 - "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would!"
