Philippians 1:9-11

Introduction:

The first two chapters focused on *fellowship*, the final three chapters will emphasize sonship. A true Christian is born of God and will abide in Christ and manifest *righteousness*. The Apostle John opens this chapter with three reasons for righteous, holy living.

I. The Father Loves us

 children of God (9x in 6 NT bk) Luke 20:36 Gal 3:26

 children of Israel (586x in 25 OT bk) sons of Israel (4x in 3 OT bk)

 1Chr 28:1 2Chr 13:5 Eze 44:15 Hos 1:10
- v2 he shall appear 1 Timothy 6:14, Titus 2:13
- v3 this hope ... purifieth 2 Corinthians 7:1

- v 4 sin defined : the transgression of the law cf 1 John 5:17
 Christ's Mission
 - v 5 (1) the sinless sin-bearer Hebrews 4:15, John 1:29, Isalah 53:5-6, 12
 - v 8 (2) to destroy the works of the devil Hebrews 2:9, 14-15
- v 6-7 Our 'manner of love' (v1) toward our Saviour's sacrifice is abiding in him (v6). This is how we doeth righteousness (v7).
