<u>The Westminster Confession of Faith</u> Chapter 19—Of the Law of God

WCF 19.3 Besides this law, commonly called moral, God was pleased to give to the people of Israel, as a church underage, ceremonial laws, containing several typical ordinances; partly of worship, prefiguring Christ, His graces, actions, sufferings, and benefits;(1) and partly of divers instructions of moral duties.(2) All which ceremonial laws are now abrogated under the new testament.(3) (1)Heb. 9; Heb. 10:1; Gal. 4:1,2,3; Col. 2:17.
