  - A. Ariel (**laeyrla**) distressed and brought low (1-4)
  - B. Ariel down, but not out (5-8)
  - C. The reason for judgment is spiritual rebellion and ignorance (9-12)
  - D. God will overthrow the superficial worship and the wisdom of the wise (13-14)
  
- II. Woe to Arrogant Clay and Praise for God's Work of Grace (15-24)
  - A. The cosmic role reversal (15-16)
  - B. The Triumph of Grace (17-21)
  - C. Grace will draw forth praise (22-24)
