Isaiah 6:1-7

- I. REVELATION: "I saw the Lord" (vv.1-4)
 - **A. Sovereign:** "sitting on a throne" (v.1)
 - 1. Awesome: "lofty and exalted" (v.1a)
 - 2. Authority: "the train...filling the temple" (v.1b)
 - **B. Sacred:** "Seraphim...called out" (vv.2-3)
 - 1. Position: "stood above Him" (v.2)
 - 2. Profession: "Holy, Holy, Holy is the LORD" (v.3)
 - C. Shaking: "the foundations...trembled" (v.4)
- II. REACTION: "Woe is me, for I am ruined" (v.5)
 - A. Conviction: "I am a man of unclean lips" (v.5a)
 - **B. Contrast:** "For my eyes have seen the King" (v.5b)
- III. <u>RELEASE</u>: "one of the seraphim flew to me" (vv.6-7)
 - **A. Symbol:** "with a burning coal in his hand" (v.6)
 - **B. Significance:** "he touched my mouth with it" (v.7)
 - 1. Personal: "this has touched your lips" (v.7a)
 - 2. Payment: "your iniquity is taken away" (v.7b)
 - 3. Pardon: "your sin is forgiven" (v.7c)
