

***The Day of the Lord***  
**1 Thessalonians 5:1-11**

**Main Point:**

Knowing that Jesus is coming again for your salvation, prepare yourself accordingly and look forward to it.

1. We don't know when, but Jesus will come again for judgment.

2. As Christians, however, we don't need to be afraid of that Day.

3. Instead, we should prepare ourselves accordingly and look forward to it.

**Matthew 24:36** <sup>36</sup> "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only. (NKJV)

**Matthew 24:38-39** <sup>38</sup> "For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, <sup>39</sup> "and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. (NKJV)

**2 Corinthians 4:6** <sup>6</sup> For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (NKJV)
