1 Samuel 1:1 – 2:11

Introduction: The household's matriarch ushers in the Jewish Sabbath

I. 1:1-8: An obscure family from a remote location

Elkanah a Levite ... and a polygamist

Peninnah – fertile ... and arrogant

Hannah – loved by her husband ... but still sad

II. 1:9-20: Hannah's prayer and vow

Hannah's total inability is God's starting point

Hannah's humility (toward her husband, Eli and God)

Hannah's peace found at a throne of grace

Hannah's vow: Dedicating to God what is already His

Hannah's answer: A Son is Given

Samuel or Saul (Sh'muel – God hears or sha'ul – asked for)

III. 1:21-28: Fulfilling the vow

A three-year delay while Samuel is weaned

IV. 2:1-11: Hannah's song

A Psalm (113:7-9); a Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55)

Hannah's prophecy of a coming king and judge (v. 9-10)

Epilogue: Samuel and Jesus
