Sermon 4. 'The Work of the Holy Spirit' Ezekiel 36: 27

- > Part two of the work of the Holy Spirit set before us as a result of the New Covenant
- > God promises His people of a time to come when His Holy Spirit will dwell in them.
- > The time came when Messiah finished the work on Calvary realised at Pentecost.
- > What we have before us in Ezekiel is three successive stages of salvation explained
 - 1) Cleansing: sprinkle you with clean water
 - 2) **Renewal**: I will give you a new heart
 - 3) **Inspiration**: I will put my Spirit with you.
- In the Old Testament this was beyond their grasp, but it was foretold, promised and realise in the New Covenant. Last sermon we saw....

- 1. <u>The Holy Spirit of God brings life</u>. Your sinful nature yields death (Acts 9: 11) Paul's conversion
- The Holy Spirit of God brings light. Jesus is the light of the world (1 Pet 2: 9; John 8: 12)
- **3.** <u>The Holy Spirit of God brings conviction</u>: The Holy Spirit's mission on earth (John 16: 7, 8; Ezek 36: 31)
- 4. <u>The Holy Spirit of God brings purification</u>: Ezek 36: 27; 2 Thess 2: 13. When the Holy Spirit indwells us He infuses a new life, that new life is a fountain of holiness.
- 5. <u>The Holy Spirit of God produces preservation</u>: All true fruit must be fruit of the Holy Spirit, all true praying must be praying in the Holy Spirit (John 6: 63).
- 6. <u>The Holy Spirit gives guidance</u>: The Holy Spirit is given to us to lead us into all truth (John 16: 13).
- 7. <u>The Holy Spirit will bring you consolation</u>: Jesus calls Him the helper. God alone can comfort us from the burden of sin, no man can do it. (Acts 9: 31)
