



The Provision of the Cities v.1-3

The Right use of the Cities. 4-10

4 And this is the case of the slayer, which shall flee thither, that he may not your enemy, live: Whoso killeth his neighbour ignorantly, whom he hated not in time past; KJV

⁴ If you accidentally kill someone who is you may escape to any of these cities and be safe. (TEV)



5 As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the axe to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live: KJV

⁵ For example, if two of you go into the forest together to cut wood and if, as one of you is chopping down a tree, the ax head comes off the handle and kills the other, you can run to one of those three cities and be safe (TEV)

6 Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he was not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.

⁶ If there were only one city, the distance to it might be too great, and the relative who is responsible for taking revenge for the killing might catch you and angrily kill an innocent person. After all, it was by accident that you killed someone who was not your enemy (TEV)

7 Wherefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt separate three cities for thee KJV

⁷This is why I order you to set aside three cities.

8 And if the LORD thy God enlarge thy coast, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers, and give thee all the land which he promised to give unto thy fathers

three more cities. (He will give you this land if you do everything that I command you today and if you love the LORD your God and live according to his teachings.) (TEV)

¹⁰ Do this, so that innocent people will not die and so that you will not be guilty of putting them to death in the land that the LORD is giving you.(TEV)




The Illegitimate use of the Cities

What is Justice?

- Hard to define, easier to define injustice
- Injustice is the abuse of power to take away from others those things that God intended for them namely, their life, liberty, dignity & fruit of their love and labour.

What is the relationship between justice and fairness?



What is the relationship between justice and fairness?

The sweet spot is in the middle, where law, justice and fairness come together to the satisfaction of all. In real life, however, we may have to settle for achieving one overlap: an outcome that's fair and just but not necessarily what the courts would do; or an outcome that's just and legal but not necessarily what the parties regard as fair; or indeed one that is fair and legal but doesn't fulfil wider ideas of justice. Whether some outcomes only fulfil one of the three poles
