They Continued Steadfastly in the Apostles' Teaching (Acts 2:42)

- God established the church: time & history on the foundation of Jesus Christ
- Four things are key regarding His keeping, reforming & reviving the church:
- 1) The Lord alone is the builder of the Church.
- 2) The Church is the outworking of God's eternal plan.
- 3) The Church is the most precious reality- for her Jesus bled and died.
- 4) The Church is God's redeemed community & heaven's expression on earth.
- The simple characteristics of the New Covenant church after Pentecost are:
- 1. APOSTLES' TEACHING
- 2. FELLOWSHIP
- 3. THE BREAKING OF BREAD
- 4. PRAYER

I. They Devoted Themselves to the Apostles' Teaching

- The teaching of the apostles lit. the *didache* of the apostles
- Jesus prayed for them to be sanctified by the truth through the Holy Spirit (The Word: John 17:17, 19; the Spirit of truth John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13)
- Peter later exhorts believers to eagerly desire the milk of the word (1 Pet 2:2)
- Truth's important: what truth did disciples continue in? Apostolic teaching!
- Acts 2: 17-36: Jesus of Nazareth: Christ, seed of David, Anointed One (2:31)
- Jesus is the Lord, raised from the dead exalted to God's right hand (2:33-36)

II. The Authority of the Apostles

- Teaching of the New Testament given by the apostles but came from Jesus
- 1 Thess 4:1-2; foundation of the apostles and prophets: Eph 2:20; 2 Tim 3:16

III. Sola Scriptura - The Living, Enduring Word of God.

• True Christianity experience of Lord Jesus Christ based on the apostolic teachings. It is a matter of life or death (1 Tim 4:16)
