 - d. The impact of our hope on our lives—1:12—2:11
 - 1) We are to be 'holy and He is holy"—1:14-16
 - 2) We are to "conduct ourselves with fear"—1:17-21
 - 3) "Fervently love one another"—1:22-25
 - 4) "Growing Up" in our faith—2:1-11
 - a) As "new born babes"—2:1-3
 - b) As "living stones"—2:4-8
 - c) As "God's chosen people"—2:9-11
