 - B. Dancing before the Lord (see Exodus 25:14; Deuteronomy 10:8; 1 Samuel 2:18; 22:18; 1 Chronicles 15:27)
 - C. Prince, priest, and prophet (Joshua 22:6-7; Exodus 39:43; 1 Samuel 17:45; 20:42), and now he blesses the people by the name of the Lord
- II. Some reasonable concerns
 - A. Dancing before the Lord and everyone else!
 - B. David and the ladies
 - C. A marriage breaking (1 Samuel 18:16, 20; 2 Samuel 3:16)

III. Honor

- A. Saul and his house: glory comes from men (see 1 Samuel 9:16; 10:1; 13:14; 25:30)
- B. David: glory comes from God
- C. Glory and delight (1 Corinthians 11:7)
- D. To glorify God and enjoy him forever! (2 Samuel 22:20b/Psalm 18:19b; Isaiah 42:1;
 1 Corinthians 1:20, 23
