

## **Redemption Ephesians 1:7-10**

### **Introduction**

NJFK—household management—family chores with a goal in mind

<sup>7</sup> In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, <sup>8</sup> which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight <sup>9</sup> making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ <sup>10</sup> as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

1. God's Gracious Gift in Christ (7-8)
2. God's Revealed Purpose in Christ (9-10)

### **1. God's Gracious Gift in Christ (7-8)**

<sup>7</sup> In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, <sup>8</sup> which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight

**Redemption**—redeem/ransom means to buy back

Human beings (and all universe) belong to God because He created everyone and everything.

Sin/Satan—a liar, thief, and murderer

God bought us back from our slavery to lies, sin, and death

Price—his blood  
Innocent life for the guilty

**Forgiveness**—release, pardon, cancel a debt

of our **trespasses**—false step, transgression  
We all have stepped over God’s “no trespassing” signs, His boundaries.

The measure of forgiveness God provides—  
“According to the riches of his grace”

Which he **lavished** on us—overflowing abundance

In all **wisdom and insight**—His gift to us touches all areas of skillful living and practical understanding

Colossians 1:9-10

And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.

## 2. God's Revealed Purpose in Christ (9-10)

<sup>9</sup> making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ <sup>10</sup> as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

The **mystery** of his will—once hidden, now revealed

According to his **purpose**—his good pleasure  
Same expression in 1:5 “according to the purpose of his will”

Which he set forth in Christ . . .

v. 10

As a **plan**—household management, administration, hence a plan or strategy

For the fullness of **time** (*kairos*, not *chronos*—a season of opportunity, versus just the passing days on the calendar)

To **unite** all things—to gather together (KJV)—in Him

“All things” equals

The things in heaven (the heavens) and the things on the earth

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

The universal headship of Christ—all things visible and invisible were created through Him and for Him (Colossians 1:16)

Because of His cross work, Christ has been given all authority over heaven and earth (Matthew 28:18), but it will not be fully realized till the end of the age

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
