1. Jesus knows who is truly **humble** (verses 1-5)
 - a. Humble servants are confident in their **identity**
 - b. Humble servants are complete in their **task**
 - c. Humble servants are content with their **positions** (and possessions)
 - d. Humble servants are confident about their **destiny**
2. Jesus knows who is really **holy** (verses 6-11)
 - a. We come once to be **completely** holy. (Wholly holy)
 - i. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 [1 Co 6:9](#) Do not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, [10](#) nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. [11](#) And such were some of you. **But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.
 - ii. 1 Peter 1:18-19 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, [19](#) **but with the precious blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.
 - b. We come often to be **continually** holy.
 - i. 1 John 1:7-9 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son **cleanses us from all sin**. [8](#) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. [9](#) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to **cleanse us from all unrighteousness**.
3. Jesus knows what brings **genuine happiness** (verses 12-17)
 - a. Happiness **depends** on **who you know**
 - b. Happiness **deepens** on what you know
 - c. Happiness is **determined** by doing what you know to do (verse 17)

4. Jesus knows who is deceived by hypocrisy (verses 18-30)

- a. A hypocrite may walk with the Truth
- b. A hypocrite may witness His transforming power
- c. A hypocrite may work with His team
- d. A hypocrite may even worship with the group.
- e. But a hypocrite has never truly **been washed**.

- i. Matthew 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. [22](#) Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' [23](#) And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'

*How close to salvation can a person get and yet be eternally lost? Just think of **Judas**.*
