Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

2. The Contentious

Thus says the Lord: stand by the roads, and look and ask for the ancient paths, ... **Jer. 6:16**

"Ancient Paths"? -

Just because it is modern, recent, or accepted in today's culture is it therefore truth?

... where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls...

But they said, "we will not walk in it."

... they refused to love the truth and so be saved. 2 Thess. 2:10

3. The Confused.

Berea - ...they received the Word with all eagerness examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so. **Acts 17:11**

(Paul speaking to Felix and Drusilla)

And as he reasoned about -

righteousness self control

the coming judgment (Acts 24:25)

Felix was alarmed and said, "Go away for the present." Acts 24:25

What are the three spiritual issues concerning the topic of homosexuality?

1. Wisdom of God or the wisdom of the world?

Arguments and lofty opinions raised against the knowledge of God. 2 Cor 10:5

Complexity of Reasons or Contributing factors

- Strong feminine influences

- Sensitive temperament; emotional turmoil
- Failure to emotionally bond with father/ mother
- Abuse
- Pornography
- Identity Confusion
