Grown-Ups In The Room Pt.18: **“We Forgot To Love Our Own.”**

**I Text:**

Old Covenant: *Psalm 34:11-16*

New Covenant: *1Peter 3:8-13*

**II Doctrine:** After the Apostle establishes the God ordained hierarchy in the Church, he now focuses on interpersonal doctrine for Christians. God’s chosen people are to treat one another with the first fruits of love. Too often Christians are extremely kind to those outside the Church, and mean spirited with their own people. Jesus Christ himself exercises grace with those who believe in him.

Let the believer who claims to love the Messiah follow his commands. Exercise the principles of the Ten commandments in a intrapersonal and interpersonal way. We must always seek peace with God and the brethren.

Many who claim to be Christians stir up trouble and dissension where ever they go. Do not expect the Lord to protect you and answer your prayers. Seek a life of maturity in the Gospel, because God is watching you.

2) Let the believer who claims to love the Messiah follow his commands. Exercise the principles of the Ten commandments in a intrapersonal and interpersonal way. We must always seek peace with God and the brethren. (*1Peter 3:10,11; Matthew 5:17-20; Psalm 34:11-13*)

3) Many who claim to be Christians stir up trouble and dissension where ever they go. Do not expect the Lord to protect you and answer your prayers. Seek a life of maturity in the Gospel, because God is watching you. (*1Peter 3:12,13; Psalm 34:14-16*)
