

- 1  **"For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."**  
Luke 19:10
- 2  **Luke 24:25–26**  
And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?"
- 3  **Luke 24:27**  
Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.
- 4  **Luke 18:31**  
Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished.
- 5  **Luke 16:29, 31**  
They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them. ... If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.
- 6  **The Words of the Prophets**  
Messiah Brings Salvation
- 7  **Genesis 3:15**  
And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, and you shall bruise him on the heel.
- 8  **Genesis 3:21**  
The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.
- 9  **Genesis 4:3–5**  
So it came about in the course of time that Cain brought an offering to the LORD of the fruit of the ground. Abel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and for his offering; but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard.
- 10  **Genesis 8:20–22**  
Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird and offered burnt offerings on the altar.  
The LORD smelled the soothing aroma.
- 11  **Genesis 22:1–2**  
Now it came about after these things, that God tested Abraham .... He said, "Take now your son, your only son, whom you love, Isaac, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I will tell you."
- 12  **Genesis 22:12–13**  
He said, "Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me."  
Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of

his son.

13  **Exodus 12:3–5**

On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers' households, a lamb for each household. ... Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old ....

14  **Exodus 12:6–7**

You shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight. Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.

15  **Exodus 12:13**

The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

16  **Exodus 12:46**

It is to be eaten in a single house; you are not to bring forth any of the flesh outside of the house, nor are you to break any bone of it.

17  **Numbers 21:8–9**

Then the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a standard; and it shall come about, that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, he will live." And Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on the standard; and it came about, that if a serpent bit any man, when he looked to the bronze serpent, he lived.

18  **Isaiah 53:4**

Surely our griefs He Himself bore,  
And our sorrows He carried;  
Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken,  
Smitten of God, and afflicted.

19  **Isaiah 53:5**

But He was pierced through for our transgressions,  
He was crushed for our iniquities;  
The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him,  
And by His scourging we are healed.

20  **Isaiah 53:6**

All of us like sheep have gone astray,  
Each of us has turned to his own way;  
But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all  
To fall on Him.

Messiah's Rejection by God

22  **Psalms 22:1–3**

My God, my God, why have You forsaken me?  
Far from my deliverance are the words of my groaning.  
O my God, I cry by day, but You do not answer;

And by night, but I have no rest.  
 Yet You are holy,  
 O You who are enthroned upon the praises of Israel.

23  **Isaiah 53:4, 6, 10**

[He was] smitten of God, and afflicted. ...  
 The LORD has caused the iniquity of us all  
 To fall on Him. ...  
 The LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief.

24  **Deuteronomy 21:23**

he who is hanged [on a tree] is accursed of God

25  **The Words of the Prophets**

Messiah's Rejection by the People

26  **Isaiah 53:3**

He was despised and forsaken of men,  
 A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief;  
 And like one from whom men hide their face  
 He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

27  **Psalm 41:9**

Even my close friend in whom I trusted,  
 Who ate my bread,  
 Has lifted up his heel against me.

28  **Psalm 55:12-13**

For it is not an enemy who reproaches me,  
     Then I could bear it;  
 Nor is it one who hates me who has exalted      himself against me,  
 Then I could hide myself from him.  
 But it is you, a man my equal,  
 My companion and my familiar friend

29  **Zechariah 11:12-13**

So they weighed out thirty shekels of silver as my wages. Then the Lord said to me, "Throw it to the potter, that magnificent price at which I was valued by them." So I took the thirty shekels of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

30  **Psalm 31:11**

Because of all my adversaries, I have become      a reproach,  
 Especially to my neighbors,  
 And an object of dread to my acquaintances;  
 Those who see me in the street flee from me.

31  **Psalm 22:7-8**

All who see me sneer at me; They separate with the lip, they wag the head, saying,  
 "Commit yourself to the LORD; let Him deliver him; Let Him rescue him, because He delights in him."

32  **Psalm 22:14-15**

I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint;

My heart is like wax; It is melted within me.  
 My strength is dried up like a potsherd,  
 And my tongue cleaves to my jaws;  
 And You lay me in the dust of death.

33  **Psalm 22:16–18**

For dogs have surrounded me;  
 A band of evildoers has encompassed me;  
 They pierced my hands and my feet.  
 I can count all my bones.  
 They look, they stare at me;  
 They divide my garments among them,  
 And for my clothing they cast lots.

34  **Isaiah 50:6**

I gave My back to those who strike Me,  
 And My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard;  
 I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.

35  **The Words of the Prophets**

Messiah's Death and Burial

36  **Deuteronomy 21:22–23**

If a man has committed a sin worthy of death and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree, his corpse shall not hang all night on the tree, but you shall surely bury him on the same day (for he who is hanged is accursed of God), so that you do not defile your land which the LORD your God gives you as an inheritance.

37  **Zechariah 12:10**

I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

38  **Psalm 69:20–21**

Reproach has broken my heart and I am so sick.  
 And I looked for sympathy, but there was none,  
 And for comforters, but I found none.  
 They also gave me gall for my food  
 And for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

39  **Leviticus 17:10–12**

And any man ... who eats any blood, I will set My face against that person who eats blood and will cut him off from among his people. For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.

40  **Psalm 109:1–2**

O God of my praise, Do not be silent!  
 For they have opened the wicked and deceitful mouth against me;  
 They have spoken against me with a lying tongue.

41  **Psalm 109:3-5**

They have also surrounded me with words of hatred,  
 And fought against me without cause.  
 In return for my love they act as my accusers;  
     But I am in prayer.  
 Thus they have repaid me evil for good and hatred for my love.

42  **Psalm 31:13**

For I have heard the slander of many,  
 Terror is on every side;  
 While they took counsel together against me,  
 They schemed to take away my life.

43  **Psalm 31:5**

Into Your hand I commit my spirit;  
 You have ransomed me, O LORD, God of truth.

44  **Isaiah 53:9**

His grave was assigned with wicked men,  
 Yet He was with a rich man in His death,  
 Because He had done no violence,  
 Nor was there any deceit in His mouth.

45  **The Words of the Prophets**

On Resurrection

46  **Psalm 16:8-11**

I have set the LORD continually before me;  
 Because He is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.  
 Therefore my heart is glad and my glory rejoices;  
 My flesh also will dwell securely.  
 For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol;  
 Nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.  
 You will make known to me the path of life ....

47  **Psalm 22:19-24**

But You, O LORD, be not far off; O You my help, hasten to my assistance.  
 I will tell of Your name to my brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You.  
 For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; Nor has He hidden His face from him; But when he cried to Him for help, He heard.

48  **Psalm 30:1-3**

I will extol You, O LORD, for You have lifted me up,  
 And have not let my enemies rejoice over me.  
 O LORD my God, I cried to You for help, and You healed me.  
 O LORD, You have brought up my soul from Sheol;  
 You have kept me alive, that I would not go down to the pit.

49  **Psalm 49:15**

But God will redeem my soul from the power of Sheol, For He will receive me.

50  **Psalm 73:24**

With Your counsel You will guide me,  
And afterward receive me to glory.

51  **Psalm 118:17–18**

I will not die, but live, And tell of the works of the LORD.  
The LORD has disciplined me severely, But He has not given me over to death.

52  **Psalm 118:22–23**

The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief corner stone.  
This is the Lord's doing; It is marvelous in our eyes.

53  **The Words of the Prophets**

Messiah's Ascension and Enthronement

54  **Psalm 110:1**

The LORD says to my Lord:  
"Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

55  **Daniel 7:14**

And to Him was given dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not pass away; and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed.

56  **The Words of the Apostles**

57  **Acts 3:18–25**

But the things which God announced beforehand by the mouth of all the prophets, that His Christ would suffer, He has thus fulfilled. ... all things about which God spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets from ancient time. Moses said .... All the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and his successors onward, also announced these days.

58  **Acts 7:51–52**

You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are always resisting the Holy Spirit; you are doing just as your fathers did. Which one of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? They killed those who had previously announced the coming of the Righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers you have now become ....

59  **Acts 8:26–35**

An Ethiopian eunuch ... had come to Jerusalem to worship, and he was returning and sitting in his chariot, and was reading the prophet Isaiah.

...

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him.

60  **Acts 10:43**

Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins.

61  **Acts 13:27**

For those who live in Jerusalem, and their rulers, recognizing neither Him nor the utterances of the

prophets which are read every Sabbath, fulfilled these by condemning Him.

62  **Acts 17:2**

And according to Paul's custom, he went to them, and for three Sabbaths reasoned with them from the Scriptures.

63  **Acts 17:10–12**

The brethren [in Thessalonica] immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so. Therefore many of them believed, along with a number of prominent Greek women and men.

64  **Romans 1:1–4**

Paul, a bond-servant of Christ Jesus, called as an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, which He promised beforehand through His prophets in the holy Scriptures, concerning His Son, who was born of a descendant of David according to the flesh, who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord.

65  **Acts 24:14**

But this I admit to you, that according to the Way which they call a sect I do serve the God of our fathers, believing everything that is in accordance with the Law and that is written in the Prophets.

66  **Acts 26:22–23**

So, having obtained help from God, I stand to this day testifying both to small and great, stating nothing but what the Prophets and Moses said was going to take place; that the Christ was to suffer, and that by reason of His resurrection from the dead He would be the first to proclaim light both to the Jewish people and to the Gentiles.

67  **Acts 28:23**

When they had set a day for Paul, they came to him at his lodging in large numbers; and he was explaining to them by solemnly testifying about the kingdom of God and trying to persuade them concerning Jesus, from both the Law of Moses and from the Prophets, from morning until evening.

68  **Acts 28:24**

Some were being persuaded by the things spoken, but others would not believe.

69  **Acts 28:25–26**

And when they did not agree with one another, they began leaving after Paul had spoken one parting word, "The Holy Spirit rightly spoke through Isaiah the prophet to your fathers, saying,

70  **Acts 28:26–27**

GO TO THIS PEOPLE AND SAY,  
 "YOU WILL KEEP ON HEARING, BUT WILL NOT UNDERSTAND;  
 AND YOU WILL KEEP ON SEEING, BUT WILL NOT PERCEIVE;  
 FOR THE HEART OF THIS PEOPLE HAS BECOME DULL,  
 AND WITH THEIR EARS THEY SCARCELY HEAR,  
 AND THEY HAVE CLOSED THEIR EYES;  
 OTHERWISE THEY MIGHT SEE WITH THEIR EYES,  
 AND HEAR WITH THEIR EARS,

AND UNDERSTAND WITH THEIR HEART AND RETURN,  
AND I WOULD HEAL THEM.”

71  **Acts 28:28**

“Therefore let it be known to you that this salvation of God has been sent to the Gentiles; they will also listen.”

72  **Ephesians 2:19–22**

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God’s household, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

73  **Hebrews 1:1–3**

God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

74  **2 Timothy 2:8**

Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, descendant of David, according to my gospel, for which I suffer hardship even to imprisonment as a criminal; but the word of God is not imprisoned.

75  **1 Peter 1:10–11**

As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries, seeking to know what person or time the Spirit of Christ within them was indicating as He predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow.

76  **2 Peter 1:19**

So we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts.

77  **2 Peter 3:1–2**

This is now, beloved, the second letter I am writing to you in which I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, that you should remember the words spoken beforehand by the holy prophets and the command of the Lord and Savior spoken by your apostles.

78  **Revelation 10:7**

... in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as He preached to His servants the prophets.
