Intro

You may have noticed some overlap, the reason for this is I wanted to make sure to keep it in context.

- 4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Faith in Testing is the focus James 1:1-16

James is really laying foundational truths that the reader will need the rest of His Letter.

James is going to deal with:

- -Favoritism
- -Word and Work
- -Faith and Works
- -Tounge how we use it
- -War
- -What faith looks like in all of it.

Last Week I talked about who James was and gave the purpose:

4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Our out look on trails as a Christian ought to be Good!

Why: They will sanctify us making us steadfast.

How are we as mere mortals to assure this Biblical outlook on trails?

Ask for Wisdom

5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.

7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

V5. omits But that is in the Greek!

What James is saying, 4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

BUT if any of you lacks wisdom!

I just want to raise my hand right here, and go ME ME!

James will have alot to teach us about wisdom: Just turn over

James 3:13-18

- 13 Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom.
- 14 But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth.
- 15 This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic.
- 16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice.
- 17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.
- 18 And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

James defines wisdom and tells us if during trials you lack the wisdom to get sanctification out of trials ASK

God will not rebuke you for asking for Wisdom to grow and worship God!

Wisdom comes from Fear of the Lord

Proverbs 9:10

10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.

Wisdom is In Jesus

Colossians 2:3

3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

When trails come, ask for Health, Wealth, Job, ---- ME ME ME ME

Ask for Wisdom to Know God more, Server Him Better, and to learn to be more like my savor during trials....

Turn you trail prayers into Godly prayers and not self centered, self worshipping prayers...

How Do We Ask?

6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.

7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

ASK Like God Is a Good God!

Wisdom begins with --- Fear of the Lord

We are to ask Him as a Good Generous God.

-In all other false religions and false gods this is a contradiction....

Illustration:

"Aslan is a lion- the Lion, the great Lion." "Ooh" said Susan. "I'd thought he was a man. Is he-quite safe? I shall feel rather nervous about meeting a lion"...

"Safe?" said Mr Beaver ..."Who said anything about safe? 'Course he isn't safe. But he's good. He's the King, I tell you."

James compels the Church, ASK God for wisdom, and believe He is able and will give it to you!

We just looked at the Positive! Now the Negative.

6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.

7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

God is God and he has supplied every breath, and you question His ability to give you wisdom for trails?

The One who Doubts falls into One of Two Categories (Biblically Speaking)...

- 1. They doubt and are tossed because they are wicked
 - a. Isaiah 57:20
 - b. 20 But the wicked are like the tossing sea; for it cannot be quiet, and its waters toss up mire and dirt.
- 2. They are Immature in the Lord
 - a. Ephesians 4:14
 - b. 14 so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.
 - c. Read this chapter in context at your leisure... Basically He gave he church and such for Your growth in Unity so that you wouldnt be tossed with every wind of doctrine

Conclusion is the same:

If you dont have faith that God will answer your prayers

7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

Lack of Faith in God affects every facet of Life

8 he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

1:8 double-minded man. A lit. translation of the Gr. expression that denotes having one's mind or soul divided between God and the world (see note on 4:4). This man is a hypocrite, who

occasionally believes in God but fails to trust Him when trials come, and thus receives nothing. The use of this expression in 4:8 makes it clear that it refers to an unbeliever. unstable. See notes on v. 6.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith.

It is a Grace from God to You

Eph 2:8 For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God.

It Grows by the Word of God

Rom 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Faith is given in salvation, but even John the Baptist Struggled!

Losing Sight of Jesus is a sinking Prospect: Illustration from Scriptures

Matthew 14:28–32

- 28 And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water."
- 29 He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus.
