Main Point:

The scribes and Pharisees are condemned hypocrites; therefore, follow the way of your true Teacher.

- 1. Jesus does not want you to follow the example of the scribes and Pharisees.
- 2. The scribes and Pharisees were proud and loved the praise of men.
- 3. The scribes and Pharisees kept people from salvation and took sin lightly.
- 4. The scribes and Pharisees had the wrong priorities.
- 5. The scribes and Pharisees were condemned.
- 6. Follow the way of your true Teacher, not the scribes and Pharisees.
