1. _____ Security Of The Believer

- The Evidences Of This Doctrine In Other Religions
 - Catholic Church Salvation Is Lost When One Commits A Mortal Sin.
 - $\circ~$ Pentecostal/Holiness Church Loss Of Salvation When One Commits Sin
 - Freewill Baptist Sin Voids Salvation
- The Excuses That Support This Ideology
- The Effect This Ideology Has On People
 - Catholic Church Establishment Of Penance
 - Pentecostal/Holiness Use This Fear To Control People
- Scriptural Evidences Of Temporary Salvation
 - Only Verses Out Of Context
 - "endure to the end"
 - "faith without works is dead"

- It Is Founded In The Forgiveness Of Sins
 - When Jesus Died He Forgave All The Sins Of Man
 - Past Sins Sins We Have Committed
 - Present Sins Sins We Are Committing
 - Future Sins Sins We Will Commit
 - (Hebrews 10:10-14)
- It Is Founded On Finished Work Of Savior
 - (John 19:30)
 - Jesus Is Not Going To Die Again
 - (1 Peter 3:18)
- It Is Fortified Through The Scriptures
 - There is Biblical Evidence For Eternal Security
 - (Philippians 1:6)
