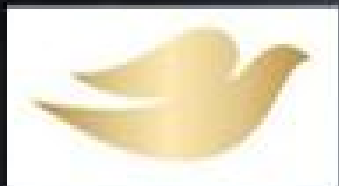

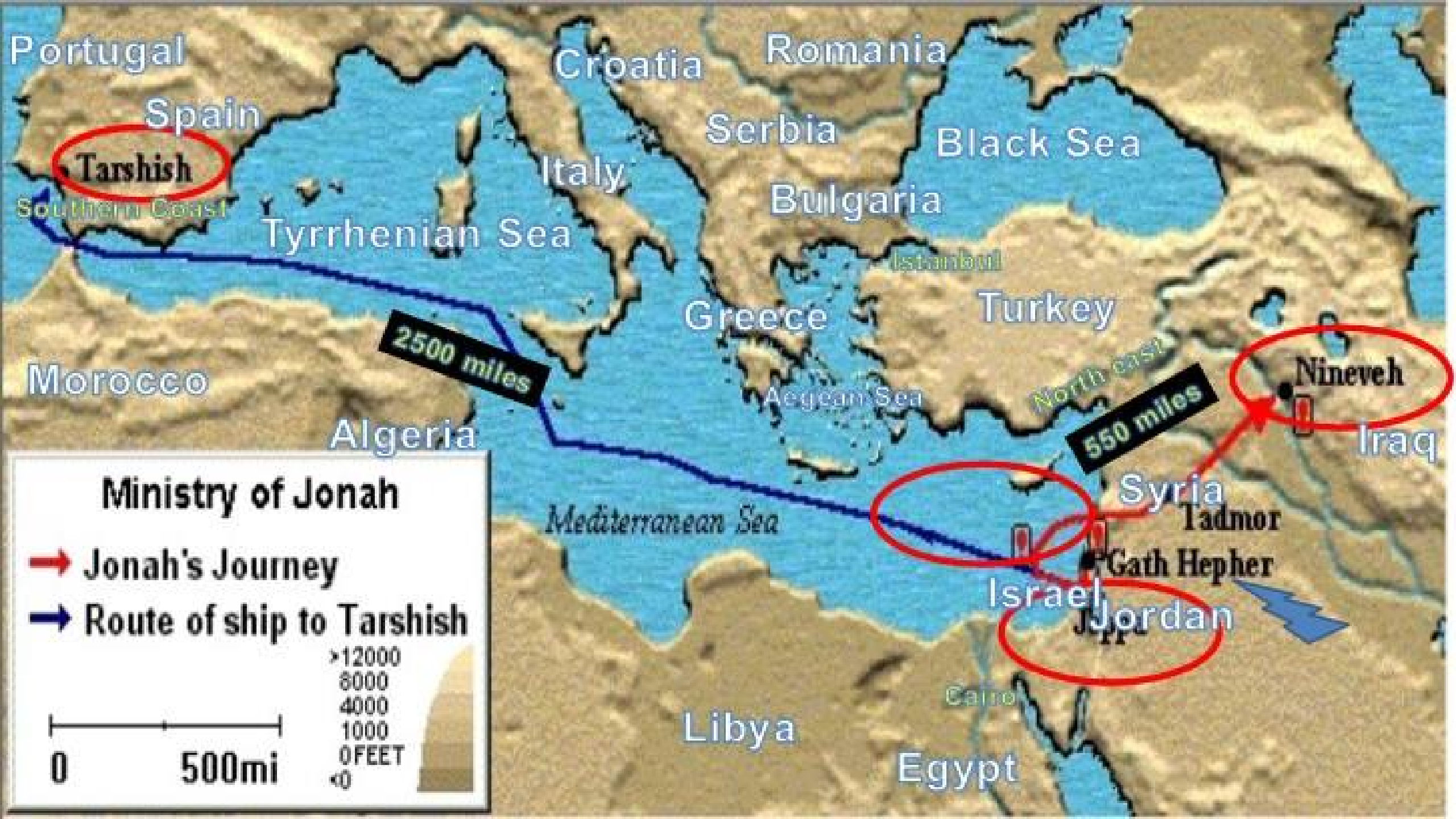

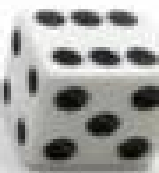
# Jonah 3:3

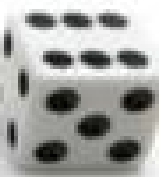

# Jonah 3:5

**5 So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. . KJV**

**5 The people of Nineveh believed God's message. So they decided that everyone should fast, and all the people, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth to show that they had repented. (TEV)**

# Jonah 3:6

**6** For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered *him* with sackcloth, and sat in ashes. **.KJV**

**6** When the king of Nineveh heard about it, he got up from his throne, took off his robe, put on sackcloth, and sat down in ashes. **(TEV)**

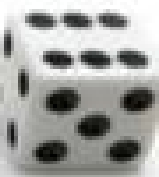


# Jonah 3:7

<sup>7</sup> And he caused *it* to be proclaimed and published through Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste any thing: let them not feed, nor drink water: **KJV**

<sup>7</sup> He sent out a proclamation to the people of Nineveh: "This is an order from the king and his officials: No one is to eat anything; all persons, cattle, and sheep are forbidden to eat or drink. **(TEV)**

# Jonah 3:8

**8 But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that *is* in their hands. **KJV****

**8 All persons and animals must wear sackcloth. Everyone must pray earnestly to God and must give up their wicked behavior and their evil actions. **(TEV)****

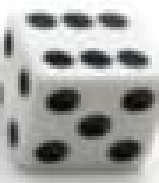


# Jonah 3:9

**9 Perhaps God will change his mind; perhaps he will stop being angry, and we will not die!" (TEV)**

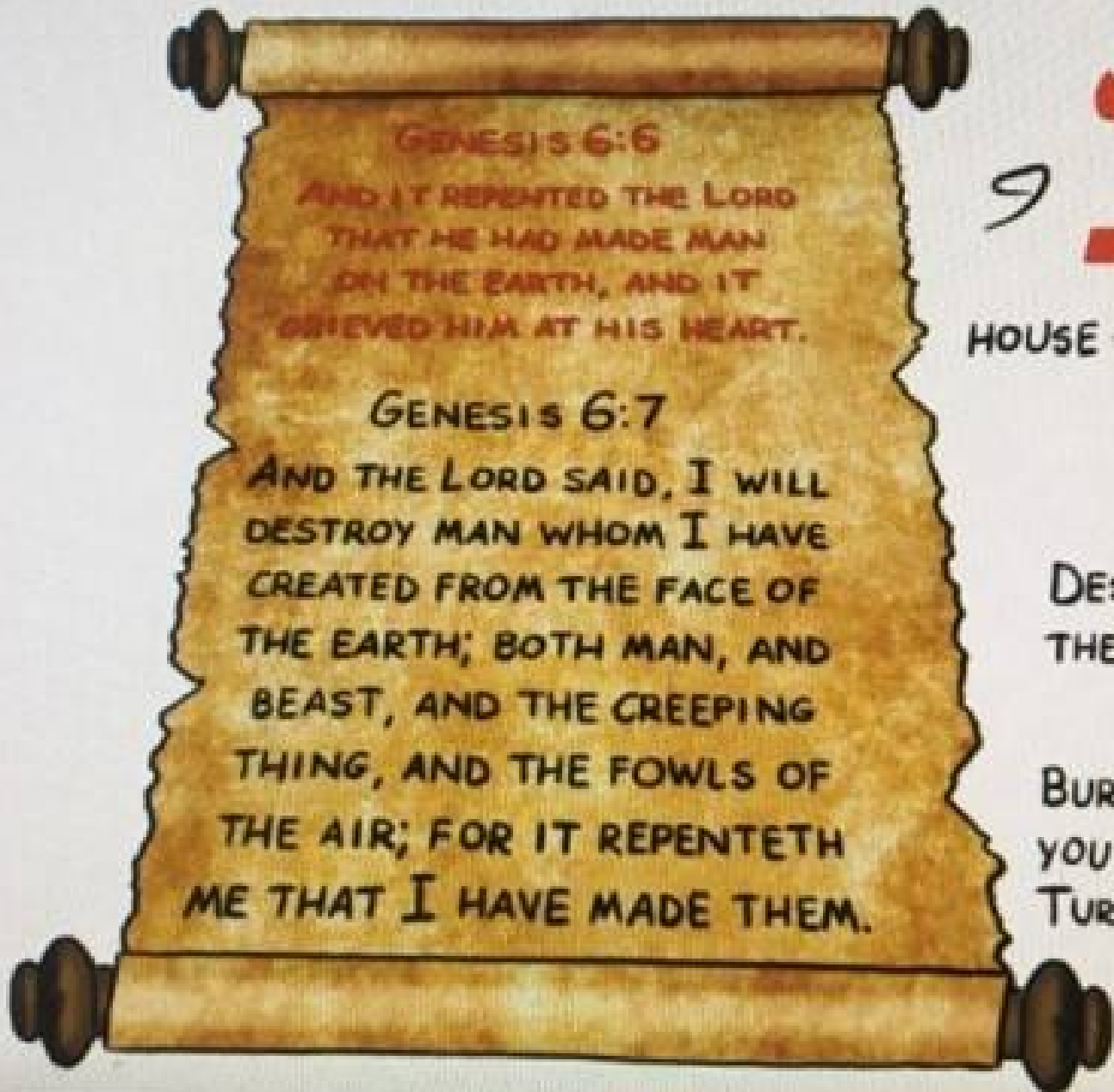

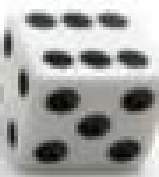
# Jonah 3:10

<sup>10</sup> **God saw what they did; he saw that they had given up their wicked behavior. So he changed his mind and did not punish them as he had said he would.**

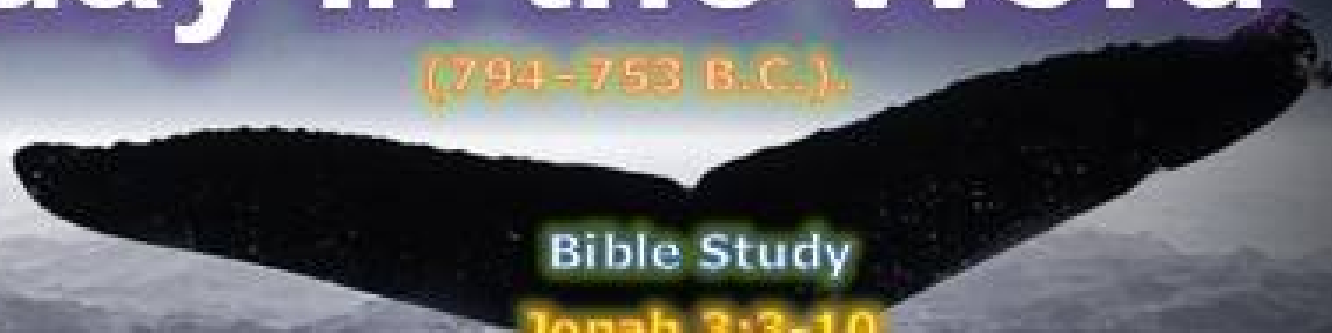
