**Introduction:** A kaleidoscope of faith.

**Enoch's daily walk with God. Hebrews 11:5–6a**

**The special nature of Enoch's daily walk with God is highlighted when you consider Enoch's last day on this earth.**

Hebrews description of the type of sweet fellowship Enoch shared with God.

**Hebrews 4:16; 7:25; 10:22**

**Hebrews 12:18–24**

*Saving produces a walk with God.*

**Romans 6:4** Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

**2 Corinthians 5:7** for we walk by faith, not by sight—

**Galatians 5:16** But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

**Ephesians 5:2** and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

*In order for the sinner to walk with God he must be reconciled to God.*

**Amos 3:3** Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

**Romans 8:6** For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace, **7** because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so, **8** and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

**Ephesians 2:3** Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

**2 Corinthians 5:17–21**

The Faith Of Enoch

Hebrews 11:5–6

*In order for the sinner to walk with God he must have a nature liken unto His.*

**2 Corinthians 6:14** Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? **15** And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? **16** And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

**2 Peter 1:4** Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

*In order for a sinner to walk with God he must surrender his will to the will of God.*

**Matthew 26:39** And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, “My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will.” **42** He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, “My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done.”

**Romans 12:1** Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. **2** And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

*Saving faith produces a daily walk with God.*

**2 Corinthians 5:7** (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

**Colossians 2:6** As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:

**1 John 2:6** He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

**3 John 3** For I was very glad when brethren came and testified to your truth, that is, how you are walking in truth. **4** I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

*Such a daily walk will be a walk of love*

**Ephesians 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

*Such a daily walk will be a walk in the light*

**Ephesians 5:8** For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

*Such a daily walk will be marked by wisdom.*

**Ephesians 5:15** See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,
