Jesus was fully human

Jesus was fully divine

- See Philippians 2:5-11. Specifically 2:7 which says he "emptied himself."
 What does this mean?
- "Christ merely surrendered the independent exercise of some of his
 relative or transitive attributes. He did not surrender the absolute or
 immanent attributes in any sense; He was always perfectly holy, just,
 merciful, truthful, and faithful." Henry C. Thiessen
- He took on human nature, Philippians 2:7-8:
 - o taking the form of a servant
 - being born in the likeness of men
 - being found in humans form
 - humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
