Sermon: Now It's Your Blood! "Nahum: Understanding God's Judgment" Pt.3

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Nahum 2:1-13* New Covenant: *Matthew 26:47-54*

II Doctrine:

Nahum gives us an amazing picture on how ancient sieges were carried out. He is describing the dominant class in Babylon, the Chaldeans rising up to overtake Assyria. We are given a description of the Babylonian army forming it's front line.

Once a breach is made in the walls of a city, the attackers can unleash the chariots upon the populace. The chariot was the "tank" of antiquity. It could reach speeds of 40 mph and weighed thousands of pounds. The moment you saw the glean of the chariot you were dead moments later.
