## The Place of Verse 16 Within Leviticus 16

a. 16:1-5; Lord addresses Moses, High Priest's entrance

b. 16:6-10; Presentation of sacrificial animal

c. 16:11-15; entrance from altar to Holy of Holies

## *16:16-17; Purge Holy of Holies and people assembled*

c<sub>1</sub>. 16:18-20; Exit from Holy of Holies to altar

b<sub>1</sub>. 16:21-22 Rejection of scapegoat animal

a<sub>1</sub>. 16: 23-34: High priest's exit, Lord addresses the people
