December 1904 at the Duke of York's Theatre
in London...**

His name and playing the flute or pipes suggest the Greek god and mythological character Pan...Traditionally, the character has been played on stage by a petite adult woman. In the original productions in the UK, Peter Pan's costume was a reddish tunic and dark green tights, such as that worn by Nina Boucicault in 1904. Peter has the ability to imagine things into existence...in Barrie's works...Peter Pan...plays pipes to the fairies and rides a goat.
