- "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." speaking of both Son/Father
- **G** He is Coming with the Clouds
- 😋 Every Eye Will See Him
- 😋 In the Tribulation
- **C** The Keys of Death and Hades

Key Learnings from 7 Letters to 7 Churches

Real Written to actual 7 historical first century churches

A Has within them

- Promises for those who remain faithful
- S Warns of impending judgments for those who are unfaithful

All believers will receive salvation, eternal life, but those who were martyred and faced severe tribulation will likely receive a distinctive reward (crown)

- 1 Cor 10:6 Now these things happened as examples for us, so that we would not crave evil things as they also craved. things written in both OT/NT are examples and warnings
- **R** It's a parable of the state of the church in the end times
  - Solution When Jesus came the 1<sup>st</sup> time, the Jews were apostate
  - Solution When Jesus comes the 2<sup>nd</sup> time, the Church will be apostate

#### Key Learnings from Revelation 4-5

**R** The throne in heaven belongs to the Father

- Iesus may very well have a seat to the right hand of the Father, nevertheless, the throne in heaven is the Father's throne
- The Father wrote the contents in the book/scroll in His right hand and sealed it with His heavenly royal signet ring 7 times (7 Seals)
  The Father may very well be adorned with a breastpiece w/12 precious stones
  "breastpiece of judgment" worn by the High Priest Ex 28:15-30
  The contents in the 7 sealed book are lamentations, mourning, and woe
  The Lamb as if Slain alone was found worthy to take the book and break open its seals

#### Key Learnings from Revelation 4-5

The 4 Living Creatures are heaven's choir director with great authority
 The 24 Elders are likely the OT saints (OT prophets) who were raised and glorified AFTER Jesus rose from the dead:

Matthew 27:50-53

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit. 51 And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split. 52 The tombs were opened, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; 53 and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the holy city and appeared to many.

- A Strong Angel, 7 Spirits of God or 7 Angels are distinct angels given specific tasks
- Myriads and myriads and thousands of thousands are elect angels who did not joint the rebellion and will wage war with Christ against Satan and the fallen angels who rebelled during the Great Armageddon

#### Where we left off: Revelation

 We started chapter 6 and the breaking of the 1<sup>st</sup> Seal and then went on quite a bit of an excursion
 First the excursion...



Equality with GodUnashamed of the Godhead

- Realized These 2 studies were really a by-product of years of study at least for me
- Reverse were some of those truths and learnings...

Jesus asked His disciples 'Who do you say that I am?"

☑ Peter answered "You are the CHRIST, the SON OF THE LIVING GOD" – Mt 16:16

IESUS IS AND WAS THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD IN HUMAN FORM

 Although Jesus is and was GOD IN THE FLESH, there were some limitations even to His greatness and omniscience compared to the Father: John 14:28 (Jesus's Own lips) You heard that I said to you, 'I go away, and I will come to you.' If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because I go to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

Matthew 24:36 (Jesus speaking) "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone

Row Not to mention, the truth that Jesus called the Father "My God"

**As He was dying on the cross** He cried out "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?" – Mt 27:46, Mk 15:34

**In the letter to Sardis** Jesus said there "Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God." – Rev 3:2

**In the letter to Philadelphia** Jesus said there "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name." – Rev 3:12

- So although Jesus is and was God, the Christ, the Son of God in the flesh, He is and was not the Father, He is not greater than His Father, He is not as omniscient as His Father in fact the Father is His God and our God too
- C Thus, when Jesus was calling God His own His Father claiming equality with God in John 5 or when Paul speaks of the humiliation and exaltation of Christ in Phi 2, this did not mean that Jesus and the Father are 50/50! Nor does this does not mean that the Father/Son/Holy Spirit are 1/3 equal and that No One in the Godhead is greater than the other

The truth in the matter is:

R The Father is the Undisputed Greatest God! God Almighty! Most High God!

When the Scripture speak of Jesus being equal with God, it is simply to be understood that Jesus is to be treated equally the same as His Father
 The Father's will is that all would honor the Son as they honor Him
 Apart from the Father, Jesus alone is to be fully worshiped, adored and obeyed!

- What about the Holy Spirit? can't get too much into it, I'm still waiting for His Word to bear fruit in my heart, but I can say a few things
   It's is the Father's Spirit Mt 3:16, Jn 4:24 ("God is Spirit")
- R It is Jesus's Spirit Act 16:7
- Real He is the Helper, Comforter, our Teacher sent by the Father in the Son's Name Jn 14:26
- It is the Holy Spirit who gives eternal life and we cannot be born again apart from Him – Jn 3
- CR Thus, we cannot be born again, know and have faith in the Father and the Son apart from the Spirit's redeeming work!

CR This in a nutshell was the excursion we took in our Equality with God and Unashamed of the Godhead studies
