#### Introduction:

We are currently at War. Did you know that. Are you aware of this. Or do you have the idea that Wars can only occur with bullets and bombs and body bags.

A couple of weeks ago, when I prayed for the Lord to direct me to the passage for the New Year, little did I know what was coming just around the corner.

I had not even planned at that time to go to Washington DC.

3767 oun (a conjunction) – therefore, now then, accordingly so. 3767 (oun) occurs 526 times in the NT and is typically translated "therefore" which means, "By extension, here's how the dots connect."

The rest of the text is filled with how and with what we are to stand.

The Participles (verbal/adjectives) they speak of action and description.

The four participles which follow the imperative 'stand', namely, 'having fastened the belt of truth', 'having put on the breastplate of righteousness' (v. 14), 'having fitted your feet' (v. 15), and 'having taken up the shield of faith' (v. 16), spell out the actions believers need to have taken if they are to stand firm. Given the context, these participles could also be taken as having an implied imperatival force.

Paul is telling us to stand, and to stand firm, but when doing so, make sure you have this equipment. Or another way of saying it is you can't stand unless you have this equipment.

When believers have made all the necessary preparations for the battle with the appropriate goal in mind, then they are to 'stand firm'. This exhortation, which has been mentioned three times before (vv. 11, 13 [twice]), is repeated, but this time it is expressed as an imperative. It is the chief admonition of the passage, and in the light of the battle imagery used throughout points to the stance of a soldier in combat, one who resolutely opposes the enemy.

With the coming of armour the body girdle disappears. Instead, to protect the thighs there is worn a kind of apron which hung under the armour, which was made of loose or sewn thongs of leather, and which was like breeches in the Roman period. c. The Roman legionary also wore above his armour a broad leather belt studded with metal which with its hanging ends, issuing in strong metal strips, protected the lower body,

In many cases this belt serves also as a sword belt, while in others the sword, or more rarely the dagger, is carried in a special strap running over the right or left shoulder.<sup>4</sup> 4. We have an admonition to watchfulness and readiness for battle. Anything that might impair mind or sense (→ IV, 967) is to be girded up high, i.e., set aside.

#### 1.The Word אֱמֵת

The word אֱמֶת, occurs about 126 times. It is used absolutely to denote a reality which is to be regarded as אָמֵן "firm," and therefore "solid," "valid," or "binding." It thus signifies what is "true." When used of persons, it sometimes expresses that which predominantly characterises their speech, action or

thought. The אִישׁ אֱמֶת is one whose conduct falls under the norm of truth and therefore a man of integrity, a נֵאֱמָן (→ πίστις).

The noun is usually in the feminine (on Dt. 13:15; 17:4,  $\rightarrow$  n. 6). Deriving from the root אמן (*'amin*), "to be firm or sure,"

In the LXX ἀλήθεια is mostly used for אֱמֶת (87 times), ἀληθινός being also used (12 times), and occasionally ἀληθής, ἀληθῶς, and ἀληθεύειν. The equivalent in Gn. 24:49; Jos. 24:14; Is. 38:19; 39:8; Da. 8:12 and 9:13 is δικαιοσύνη, δίκαιος also occurring 4 times, and πίστις only in Jer. 35(28):9; 39(32):41; 40(33):6, while in Prv. 3:3; 14:22; 16:6 the plur. πίστεις is used for the combination חֵמֶד וַאֵמֶת.

or

2. Subjective Truth, — Faithfulness, fidelity.

or

3. Moral Truth — Honesty, Truthfulness, Integrity no hypocrisy not lying.

# The best way to understand this is to know how Paul used in Ephesians. The Message of Truth

Ephesians 1:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup> In Him you also *trusted*, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

#### **The Objective Truth Doctrine**

Ephesians 4:14–15 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of

doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, <sup>15</sup> but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—

Ephesians 4:21 (NKJV)

<sup>21</sup> if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus:

#### **Moral Truth**

Ephesians 4:25 (NKJV)

<sup>25</sup> Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another.

#### **Subjective Truth**

Ephesians 5:8-13 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), <sup>10</sup> finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. <sup>11</sup> And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose *them*. <sup>12</sup> For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are

done by them in secret. <sup>13</sup> But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light.

So Paul uses it All 4 ways

I Believe that Paul doesn't have in mind just one meaning.

i.e.

Objective doctrine but not Faithfulness.

But rather

He is painting with a broad brush to include all

Truth as the Doctrine

Truth as Faithfulness

Truth as Integrity

Truth as Truthfulness

Truth as Genuineness

You can have doctrine with out Faithfulness, Integrity, Truthfulness and Genuineness So he is not just talking about knowing truth or knowing doctrine.

He has in mind more than our Orthodoxy But also

our Orthpraxy- our living it our.

But any of the others require all of them.

Faithfulness requires Integrity, which requires Truthfulness and genuineness

And to be Faithful requires a Body or a Person to be faithful to.

His Christ, who is the Truth. Who is defined in the Doctrine of The Bible

14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth,

All of the rest of the Armor is dependent on the first one mentioned.

**TRUTH** 

No Breastplate of Righteousness without Truth

No Gospel of Peace without Truth

No Faith without the Truth of the one to have faith in.

No Helmet of Salvation, if you have no truth of Salvation

No Sword of the Spirit with the Truth

No Prayer with truth of who to pray to and how to pray.

Paul knew that the foundation of this Battle lies in the Truth.

No Truth and you will be defeated.

No Truth and you become a weak and worthless soldier.

You cannot stand up against the wiles (schemes, ideological subversion) of the devil.

This is why at the very beginning, The Devil said to Eve. "Has God really Said" The Battle for the Truth as been from the very beginning,

John 8:44 (NKJV)

<sup>44</sup> You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and *does not* stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it.

Acts 5:3 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup> But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back *part* of the price of the land for yourself?

#### Acts 13:8-10 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> But Elymas the sorcerer (for so his name is translated) withstood them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. <sup>9</sup> Then Saul, who also *is called* Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him <sup>10</sup> and said, "O full of all deceit and all fraud, *you* son of the devil, *you* enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord?

#### 2 Thessalonians 2:9–13 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, <sup>10</sup> and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. <sup>11</sup> And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, <sup>12</sup> that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

<sup>13</sup> But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,

#### Revelation 12:9 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

#### Revelation 22:14–15 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> Blessed *are* those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. <sup>15</sup> But outside *are* dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.

The Greatest Battle is the battle for the Truth. It is always being attacked from every direction.

Our Culture hates the truth

Many in our country and leadership of this country
hate the truth.

#### Sadly

Many within the Church do not want the truth, and compromise or in some cases flatly deny the truth.

As a christian we are expected and commanded to know the truth.

#### John MacArthur says

"It has been a long war against God and against His truth in which the Devil has engaged. And he has employed demons, and he has employed men and women. Most effectively he has employed those people who are associated with the truth in some way....The greatest assaults against the truth don't come from the outside; they come from the inside, from apostates, defectors who name the name of Christ or once named the name of Christ and now are the enemies of Christ; who once affirmed their trust in God, belief in God, and affirmed the Scripture and have become the enemies of the Scripture. They're on the inside. Notice verse 4 of Jude, "Certain persons have crept in unnoticed." Notice verse 12, "These men are those who are hidden reefs in your love feasts when they feast with you without fear." They're on the inside, and they are deadly dangerous because they bring such devastating corruption from their position and their posture inside the Church."

So many churches are not declaring the whole counsel of God

The pick and chose the topics that best make their congregation comfortable and coming back. We are more concerned with success than faithfulness.

Churches have unwittingly joined hands with the devil in the minimization of and the exclusion of truth.

As a result we have left our soldiers, desperate for the essential equipment that makes our stand in the war possible.

Martin Luther, that noble gospel soldier, threw down the gauntlet at the feet of every Christian in every generation after him, when he said:

If I profess with the loudest voice and clearest exposition every portion of the truth of God except precisely that little point which the world and the devil are at that moment attacking, I am not confessing Christ, however boldly I may be professing Christ. Where the battle rages, there the loyalty of the soldier is proved; and to be steady on all the battlefield besides,

is mere flight and disgrace if he flinches at that point.

#### We know the truth by meditating on the the Truth

Joshua 1:8-9 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

<sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go."

Psalm 1:1-2 (NKJV)

- Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
- <sup>2</sup> But his delight *is* in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night.

Colossians 3:16 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

There is war on truth. And there are large movements afoot to take the truth away from you and your family. This has been going on for sometime but has had some restraint in the leadership of this country. But not now. It has none.

The Gates of Hell have been opened and the demons and minions are coming after you and your children.

Credible voices have been saying for months that we need to start backing things up, making hard copies of sermons and lectures. Protect the Biblical truth you have.

There coming and there coming for you.

Are you Ready.

In 1997 psychologist Nicholas Humphrey gave the Oxford Amnesty lecture for that year, the purpose of which was to argue in favor of censorship, against freedom of expression; specifically, it wants to censor "moral and religious education" especially the education that children receive at home.

"Children have the right not to have their minds addled (confused) by nonsense. And we as a society have a duty to protect them from it. So we should know more allow parents to teach their children to believe, for example, in the literal truth of the Bible, or that parents rule their lives, then we should allow parents to knock their children's teeth out or lock them in the dungeon."
