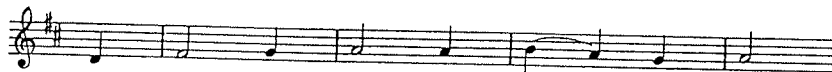

 soul de - filed, in love for - give, re - store your child.

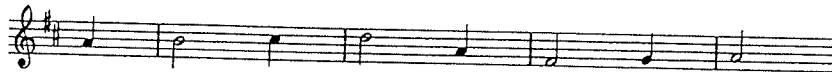

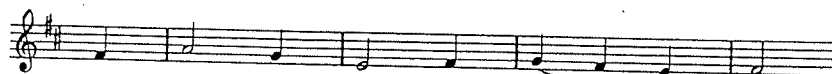
