⁷ Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

QUESTION # 67: WHAT IS EFFECTUAL CALLING?

ANSWER:

EFFECTUAL CALLING IS THE WORK OF GOD'S ALMIGHTY POWER AND GRACE,^A WHEREBY (OUT OF HIS FREE AND SPECIAL LOVE TO HIS ELECT, AND FROM NOTHING IN THEM MOVING HIM THEREUNTO^B) HE DOTHTH, IN HIS ACCEPTED TIME, INVITE AND DRAW THEM TO JESUS CHRIST, BY HIS WORD AND SPIRIT;^C SAVINGLY ENLIGHTENING THEIR MINDS,^D RENEWING AND POWERFULLY DETERMINING THEIR WILLS,^E SO AS THEY (ALTHOUGH IN THEMSELVES DEAD IN SIN) ARE HEREBY MADE WILLING AND ABLE FREELY TO ANSWER HIS CALL, AND TO ACCEPT AND EMBRACE THE GRACE OFFERED AND CONVEYED THEREIN.^F
