- 5. What would happen to Israel's king (vv. 3, 7)?
- 6. What was a big problem with the people and its leaders (v. 4)?
- 7. What would be carried out of the land and given as tribute to the great king of Assyria (vv. 5-6)?
- 8. What particular areas of sinful worship would be destroyed and would have weeds overtake them (v. 8a)?
- 9. When the terrible judgment of its sin would come upon them, how would the people respond (v. 8b)?
- 10. Who would the LORD gather against Israel to discipline her for her sins (v. 10)?
- 11. What is a common, yet erroneous, view of the nature of Old Covenant obedience and worship?
