Review Questions:

- 1. Explain what women are called to do in verse 11.
- 2. What is the significance of the word "entire" in the phrase "entire submissiveness"? How does this concept apply to everything in the Christian life?
- 3. Does this passage forbid women from teaching men? Explain.
- 4. Explain the significance of Paul appealing to creation order (Adam and Eve).
- 5. What is the ultimate point that Paul is making when he brings up the fact that Eve was deceived but Adam wasn't?
- 6. Explain Paul's main point in verse 15.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Since it is normal and optimally effective to be quiet and submit to the authority of a teacher (in both secular and religious settings), why do you think people find verse 11 so offensive?
- 2. Have you ever been in a situation where a Christian or church wants to ignore this verse or pass it off as irrelevant for today? How did they justify obeying the rest of Scripture while ignoring this one principle?
- 3. In what ways are you influenced by secular viewpoints (from culture, society, family, etc.) when it comes to this passage (or any other socially controversial passage)?
- 4. How can you develop a greater acceptance and joy in what God has called you to be (gender) and do?
- 5. What further convictions or questions do you have from this passage and/or sermon?
