## **Title:** An Introduction to the Book of Deuteronomy

**Text**: Key Verse – Deut. 1:1a "These be the words which Moses spake unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness..."

**Theme**: Blessings because of obedience and curses because of disobedience (11:26-28).

**Author** – The Holy Spirit (2 Pet. 1:21). Writer – Moses (Deut. 31:22).

**Audience** – The New (2<sup>nd</sup>) Generation Israel (Deut. 1:1-3).

**Date** – 1405 B.C.

## **Aim** or purpose –

- 1. The great leader Moses was about to die. The First Generation (20-year-olds and upward) of Israelites who exited Egypt had died in the wilderness due to their unbelief and disobedience.
- 2. Deuteronomy provides a restatement of the laws that had been given to the First Generation at Sinai.
