## Hebrews 7.11 Perfect Understanding

From the very beginning, God has shown His plan and will in a long series of progressive revelation. This revelation was by nature incomplete, giving enough light for the thing needed at the moment. But underneath it was always the promise of Christ who would complete the revelation and bring us into the fullness of understanding that is promised to the children of light... In Jesus this has been fulfilled. The Old Testament priesthood gave incomplete understanding, but our understanding has been made whole in Jesus Christ...

The Old Testament priesthood gave shadows and hints, but in Jesus our understanding has been made perfect...

The Old Testament priesthood was itself incomplete and unable to save, but the High Priest we have in Christ is perfect and whole and able to save to the uttermost...

We have perfect righteousness, perfect peace, and this morning we consider our perfect understanding.

dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; you shall be My people, and I will be your God.

- 1 Peter 1:10–12 (NKJV) <sup>10</sup> Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied

of the grace that would come to you, <sup>11</sup> searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. <sup>12</sup> To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into.

E.Hence the people of God waited for the promised light -

Isaiah 11:9 (NKJV) <sup>9</sup> They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord As the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 54:13 (NKJV) <sup>13</sup> All your children shall be taught by the Lord, And great shall be the peace of your children.

F.And that promised light included promised life Jeremiah 31:34 (NKJV) <sup>34</sup> No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord.

### For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
